# THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. After his Resurrection and before his Ascension, Jesus said to his disciples, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:16-20). Jesus, the Son of God reveals God, his Father and the Holy Spirit. We read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of the faith." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin.

*(Catechism of the Catholic Church, #234)*

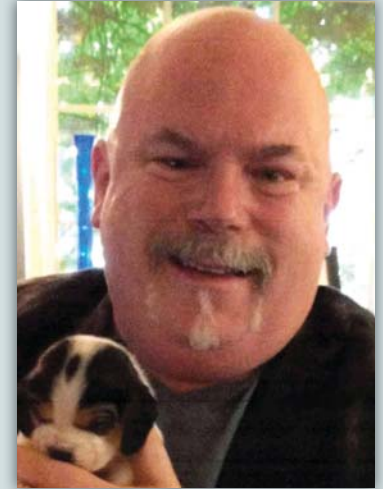
This mystery of the Most Holy Trinity "can never be known unless revealed by God" (CCC #237). The Most Holy Trinity is best summed up in love, "God is love: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (CCC #238). To find out more about the Most Holy Trinity, read the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* from #232 to #260.

St. Paul writes to the Corinthians:

You received the Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ (Romans 8:14-17).

This is a deep mystery that best comes across when we make the Sign of the Cross. We sign from head to midsection and from shoulder to shoulder, embracing and being embraced by the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, One God forever and ever. Amen.

Long-term foster care facilities in California are now being phased out, including Orangewood Children's Home, which will soon be limited to a 10-day maximum for all foster youth. A family environment is the best environment for a child in need, but this change in policy means that Orange County needs to identify an additional 300-500 new foster families very quickly.

The good news is that there are a lot of churches in Orange County with a lot of wonderful families. If each congregation found just one or two new foster families, we would have enough safe, loving homes for all our foster youth. More importantly, foster families that are part of a congregation will be better supported and nurtured. It is the nature of the Church to work as a body, and to call upon its members to support and help a foster family in their congregation.

## CHURCH RENOVATION UPDATE



The landscape drawings and civil drawings have been completed but we have encountered a delay in completing the structural detailed drawings. The architect continues to work with the structural engineer in completing the necessary detailed drawings. Bid documents will not be created until this is completed. We won't have a firm construction start date until a general contractor has been chosen. That will happen as soon as drawings are completed to the satisfaction of the architect, the project manager and the City (which has already given approval of the project) and bid documents have been provided to the contractors. We are to give the contractors a few weeks to come back with their bids; then one will be chosen.

### Project Financial Information

The project cost remains at \$7.9M and we have committed to the Diocese that it will not be more than that. That figure is inclusive of approximately 20% in unforeseen contingencies that both the estimator and the Diocese have built into the estimate. We currently have over \$4M in the bank and considering the outstanding pledges and the architecture/project management costs already paid, we will need to draw only \$1.4M of the guaranteed Diocese \$2M loan. Any additional pledge or gift will have a direct impact on what we'll have to borrow to complete the renovation.

## BUS PASSES & GIFT CARD DRIVE for HOMELESS YOUTH

After All Masses June 9-10

There are over 11,000 homeless high school students in Orange County. Some of these young people have run away from sexual, physical or emotional abuse. Many become victims of human trafficking and feel they have no home, no hope, and no way out. The charitable organization **Build Futures** takes homeless youth ages 18–24 off the streets and into a safe environment to help them become self-sufficient. **Build Futures** never turns away homeless youth seeking help.

In June, the Justice & Peace Ministry will host its fourth annual bus pass and gift card drive to assist **Build Futures**. Bus passes are essential for youth to seek jobs, resources, shelter, and ultimately a home in Orange County. One-day passes are available for \$4.50 each at many grocery stores or you can purchase them online at <https://passsales.octa.net>. Delivery of passes purchased online takes seven to 10 business days. Another great help is gift cards that youth can use to buy healthy meals at restaurants like Subway and clothing and basic necessities at stores like Walmart. ## Chúa Nhật 8 Thường Niên Năm B



*Mt 28, 16-20: Khi ấy, mười một môn đệ đi về Galilêa, đến núi Chúa Giêsu chỉ trước. Khi thấy Người, các ông thờ lạy Người, nhưng có ít kẻ còn hoài nghi. Chúa Giêsu tiến lại nói với các ông rằng: "Mọi quyền năng trên trời dưới đất đã được ban cho Thầy. Vậy các con hãy đi giảng dạy muôn dân, làm phép rửa cho họ nhân danh Cha, và Con, và Thánh Thần; giảng dạy họ tuân giữ mọi điều Thầy đã truyền cho các con. Và đây Thầy ở cùng các con mọi ngày cho đến tận thế". Đó là lời Chúa.*

## Thánh Augustine ở Canterbury (c. 605)

Vào năm 596, một nhóm đan sĩ 30 người khởi hành từ Rôma đi truyền giáo cho người Anglo-Saxon ở Anh. Dẫn đầu là Augustine, bề trên đan viện Thánh Anrê ở Rôma. Nhưng khi đến Gaul (Pháp) họ nghe những câu chuyện dã man về người Anglo-Saxon cũng như sự nguy hiểm của các luồng nước ở eo biển, họ quay trở về Rôma và gặp vị giáo hoàng đã sai họ đi - Thánh Grêgôriô Cả - và đức giáo hoàng cho biết sự lo sợ của họ thì vô căn cứ.

Một lần nữa Augustine lại ra đi, và lần này cả nhóm đã vượt qua eo biển và cập bến đất Kent thuộc về Vua Ethelbert, là người ngoại giáo kết hôn với một Kitô Hữu, bà Bertha, công chúa nước Pháp. Vua Ethelbert tiếp đón họ nồng hậu, thiết lập cho họ nơi cư trú ở Canterbury và trong năm ấy, vào Chúa Nhật Hiện Xuống năm 597, chính nhà vua đã được rửa tội.

Sau khi được tấn phong làm giám mục ở Pháp, Đức Augustine trở lại Canterbury, là nơi ngài thiết lập giáo phận và khởi công xây dựng vương cung thánh đường. Khi số tín hữu ngày càng gia tăng, các giáo phận khác được ngài mở thêm ở Luân Đôn và Rochester.

Cuộc đời Đức Augustine cũng gặp nhiều thất bại. Những cố gắng hòa giải giữa Kitô Hữu Anglo-Saxon và Kitô Hữu Briton bản xứ đã kết thúc trong thất bại đau buồn. Đức Augustine cũng không thuyết phục được người Briton từ bỏ một số phong tục khác biệt với Rôma và quên đi những cay đắng để giúp ngài phúc âm hóa người Anglo-Saxon, là kẻ xâm lăng đã dồn người Briton về miền tây.

Sau những thất bại, Đức Augustine đã khôn ngoan hơn để ý đến các nguyên tắc truyền giáo--đối với thời bấy giờ thật sáng suốt mà Đức Giáo Hoàng Grêgôriô Cả đề nghị: Hãy thanh tẩy thay vì tàn phá các đền thờ và các phong tục ngoại giáo; hãy du nhập các nghi thức và ngày lễ của người ngoại giáo vào ngày lễ Kitô Giáo; duy trì các truyền thống địa phương càng nhiều càng tốt.

Sau tám năm đến Anh, sự thành công của Đức Augustine tuy hạn hẹp nhưng sau này đã đem lại kết quả tốt đẹp là cả nước Anh đã tông giáo. Quả thật, Thánh Augustine đáng được gọi là "Tông Đồ của Anh Quốc".
