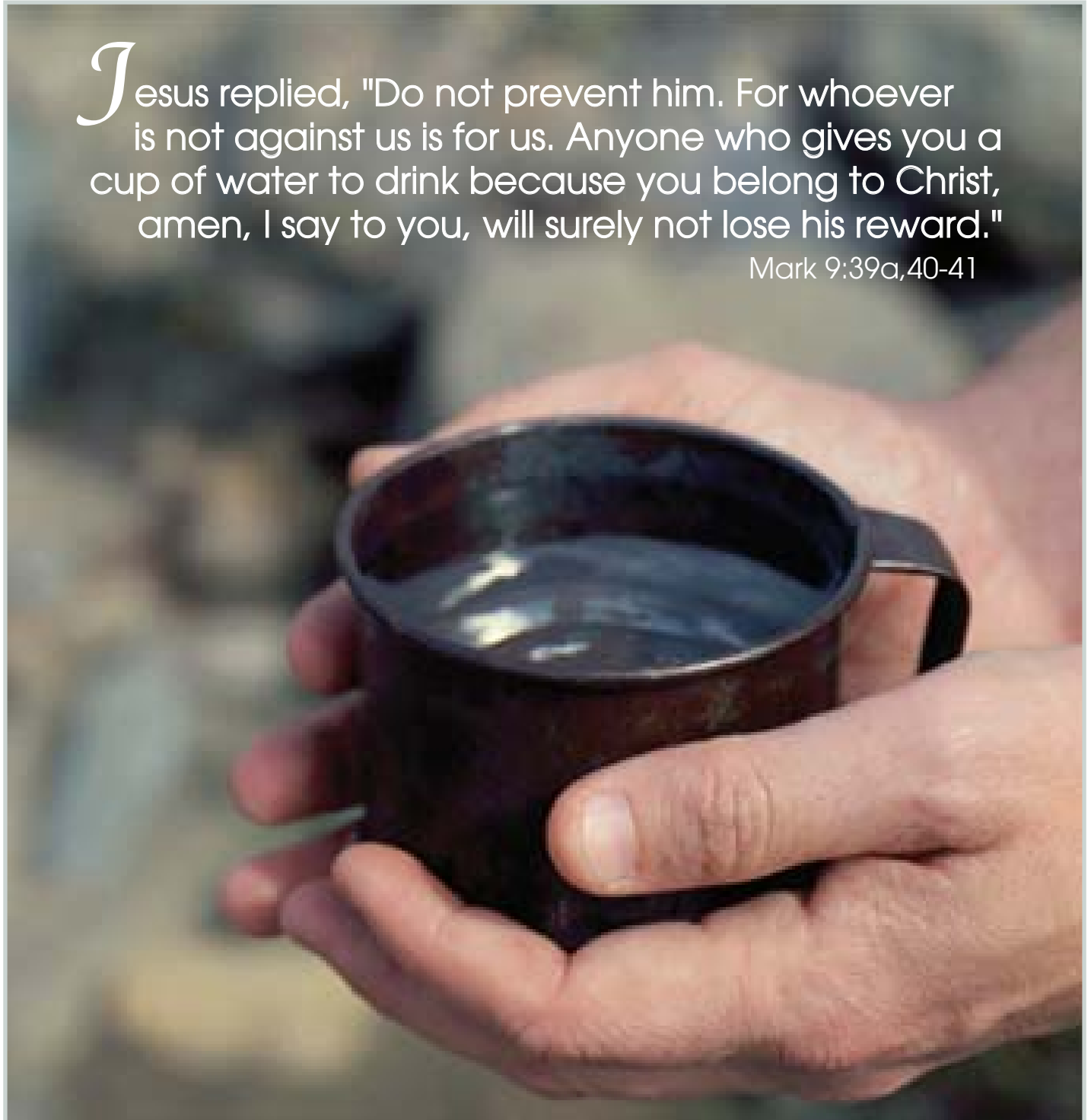

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus in today's Gospel (Mark 9:38-48) reminds us that we need to be united to Christ and his commandments. We cannot pick and choose the ones we like and discard the ones we don't. Our actions, thoughts, and words must be in line with the actions, thoughts, and words of Jesus Christ. All of us need to be good examples through living a Christ-like life. When we don't do this not only do we sin, but we can cause others to sin. Jesus tells us, "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea." (Mark 9:42)

Jesus tells us, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and the greatest commandment. The second is like it: you shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments." (Matthew 22: 37-40) These commandments are for everyone including the pope, bishops, and priests. Everyone must stand before the Lord and account for what he or she had done or failed to do.

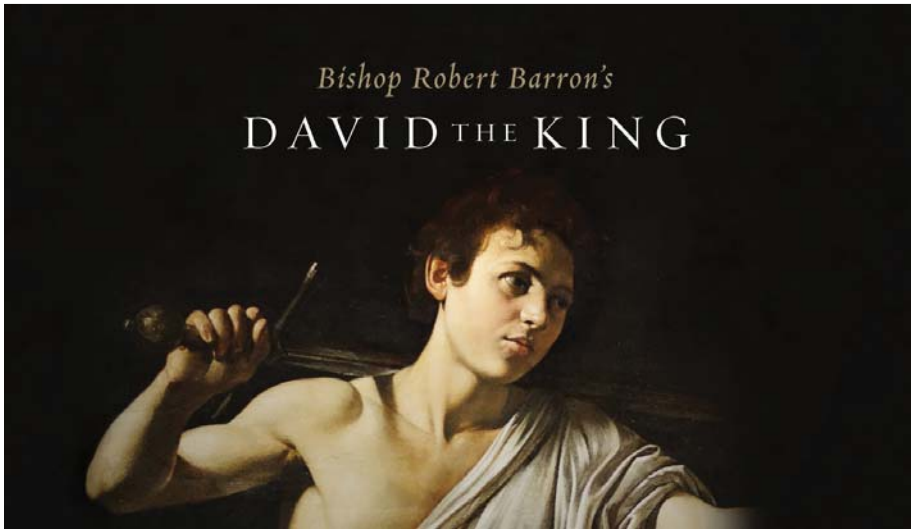

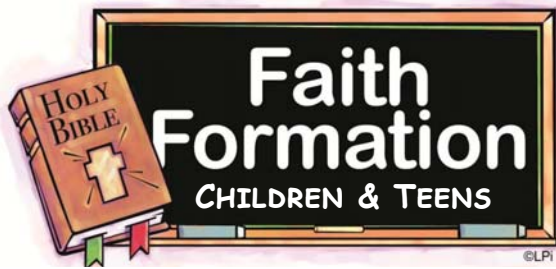

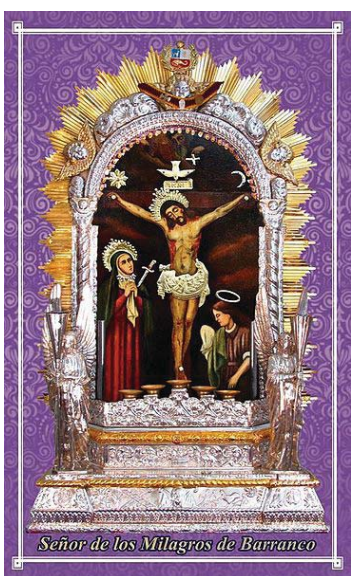
