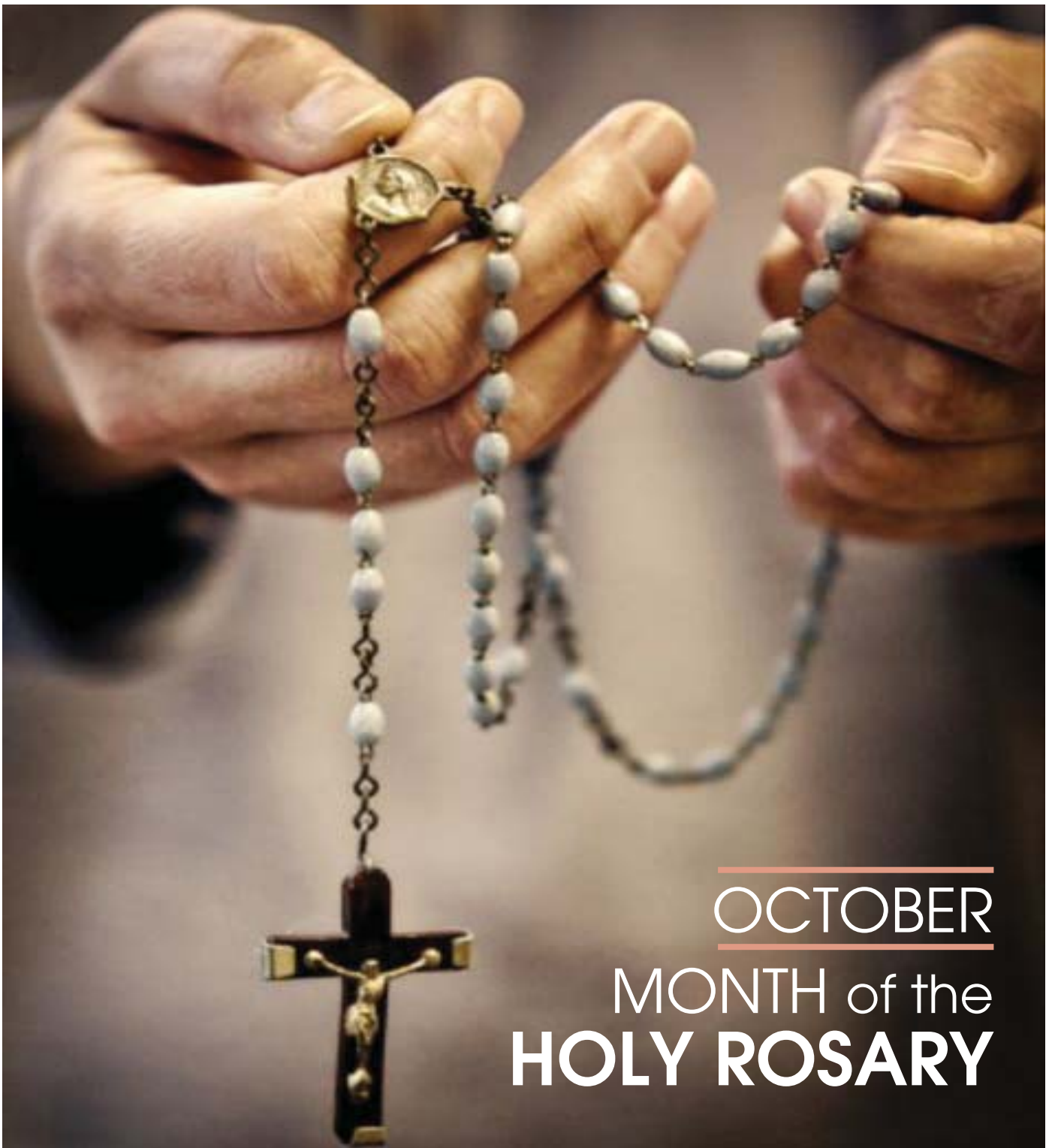

## Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I hope you are enjoying the Parish Festival this weekend. This is a great opportunity to reconnect with fellow parishioners. Spend some time getting reacquainted with old friends and meeting new ones. There is plenty of good food, rides, and games for the whole family. I look forward to seeing you at the Parish Festival.

This Sunday in the Gospel, (Mark 10:17-30) a man asked Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus listed some of the Commandments from the Book of Exodus (Exodus 20:12-17). This man told Jesus that he had followed the Commandments from his youth. Jesus looked at him, loved him and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." His face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions.

I wonder if this man later changed his mind and gave away his wealth to the poor and followed Jesus. I would like to think that he did. For now, we are left with what Jesus said to his disciples, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." The disciples thought that wealth was a sign of being blessed by God. If being wealthy wasn't a sign of blessing from God, then who can be saved? Jesus responded, "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God."

Jesus helped them see that if a wealthy person was generous to the poor, good could come from it. If a person was greedy and miserly it would bring him to ruin. If wealth is a man's master, he will go away sad. Wealth will eventually let him down, or get stolen, or ruin his life. We heard this two weeks ago in the Letter of James, "Come now, you rich, weep and wail over your impending miseries. Your wealth has rotted away, your clothes have become moth-eaten, your gold and silver have corroded and that corrosion will be a testimony against you; it will devour your flesh like a fire." (James 5:1-6)

We need to live our life in Jesus Christ. We need to be generous with the gifts God has given us. We need to cry out to God. We need to put ourselves completely into the hands of the Lord. "Into your hands, Lord, I commend my spirit." Just remember that with all the blessings, Jesus also promised "persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come."

For some it will mean giving up everything and following Jesus in poverty, chastity and obedience. Please pray for those whom Jesus is calling to consecrated life, that they will respond with generous hearts.

## CHURCH RENOVATION UPDATE

Demolition has begun. The contractor has set their fences and will begin taking down the old sacristy and removing the sloping floor. With the pews and the carpet out, the slope was very obvious. We'll know much more about the extent of the soil erosion once the floor is removed. It has been a challenge keeping to the construction schedule and putting on the festival, but I think both have been successful.

With the construction fence up, it will narrow the Springdale driveways. The south entrance (closest to Heil) will be used for an entrance only, which has been the case for the last couple of years. Eventually, the parking in front of the hall will go away and it will become a drop off point only. Please be careful, drive slowly while on campus, and be patient!

During the week, daily visitors will be able to enter the south Springdale driveway, but will have to exit onto Orlando. Please follow the cones, signs and the directions from the staff to insure a safe site for students, parishioners and visitors. ### SEÑOR DE LOS MILAGROS

Existe en Perú un mural milagroso de la Pasión de Jesucristo. Esta imagen reconocida como el Señor de los Milagros, el Cristo Moreno o el Cristo de Pachacamilla fue pintada por un angoleño en el siglo XVII para una cofradía de africanos. A mitad del siglo un fuerte terremoto sacudió a Lima y las paredes de la cofradía se cayeron, sin que se dañara el mural. Eventualmente la imagen se reveló como milagrosa para los que oraban delante de ella.

En la imagen aparece Jesús crucificado. Sobre él está el Espíritu Santo y el Padre. A la derecha de la cruz está su Madre con el corazón traspasado por una lanza y a su derecha, el fiel discípulo amado. Esta imagen es venerada como el Señor de los Milagros. Sin saberlo el artista angoleño ha pintado una reflexión teológica sobre la divinidad y la humanidad de Jesucristo. En su pasión redentora Jesús abre las puertas del cielo y de la comunicación entre el cielo y la tierra, entre Dios y la humanidad representada por la Madre y el discípulo. —*Fray Gilberto Cavazos-Glz, OFM, © J.
