“If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother.”

MATTHEW 18:15



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the Gospel Reading is taken from the Gospel according to Matthew, chapter 18, verses 15 to 20. To better understand this Reading, I would ask you to read all of Matthew, chapter 18. The chapter begins with the disciples wanting to know who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus called a child over and said, "Amen, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. And whoever receives one child such as this in my name receives me" (Matthew 18:1-5). Then Jesus demands that the disciples not cause fellow disciples (little ones) to sin. (Matthew 18:6-9) And then he demands that the disciples (by their bad actions) not cause fellow disciples to stray from the faith. But if they do, they must do everything possible to bring them back. (Matthew 18:10-14)

Now we come to today's Gospel Reading. Jesus tells them how to deal with a disciple who sins. First this must be done by one disciple. Jesus says, "If he listens to you, then you have won over your brother." But if he will not turn away from sin, then bring him before two or three disciples. If he still will not repent, then bring him to the church (the local community of disciples). Then Jesus says, "If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector" (Matthew 18:17). This would mean cutting him off from the community.

However, the chapter does not end here. Jesus tells them to pray, "If two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there I am in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20). Even though someone has been cut off from the community because of their grave sin, the church must pray that he will repent, turn away from sin and be restored to the community.

We are extremely grateful that Jesus suffered and died to free us from our sins. We are grateful that Jesus has given us the Sacrament of Penance (Confession-Reconciliation) in order to once again be freed from our sins. We must remember that we are not only confessing our sins and receiving Absolution. We must also make a firm purpose of amendment. We must show by our thoughts and actions that we are truly turning away from our sins and being faithful to God as his humble children. Remember, we cannot do this by ourselves. We must remain united with Jesus, the Son of God and our Savior.

PARISH MANAGER'S UPDATE

You've probably already heard that California has new reopening guidelines, a 4-tier, color-coded system, announced by the Governor in late August. And Orange County is currently in the worst of the 4 tiers. As of this writing, our Diocese believes that we might be able to move to a different tier in the next few weeks. If so, this would allow us to reopen our church in September. Whenever we do reopen our church, we will be back to the 100-person limit, cleaning pews after each service, overflow seating on the plaza area (with chairs provided), etc. When we do receive permission to return to the church, we will notify everyone via our website and announcements at daily Masses.

We are also hoping that our school will be able to return to on-campus learning for most students starting Tuesday, September 8. If we still have outdoor Masses on September 8, life could get a little more interesting. The school is working to schedule their activities, including morning drop-off of students, in such a way as to minimize impact on outdoor Masses. Please be sure to follow all the safety cones when school is in session.

With our Parish Hall becoming a Learning Plaza for the school, we need to install some fencing to allow students to play safely on the grass behind the Hall. Some temporary fencing will first be installed prior to September 8, with more permanent fencing scheduled for installation by the end of September.

As always, thank you all very much for the many ways that you support our parish.
