PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday is the 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time. In two weeks, we will come to the end of the Liturgical Year. As we approach the end of the Liturgical Year, the Church chooses readings that call us to prepare ourselves for the end of our earthly life. We are reminded that our bodies are fragile and earthly life only lasts so long. Are we doing the will of God right now? Are we turning away from sin and being faithful to the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

This Sunday, we are at the beginning of chapter 25 of the Gospel according to Matthew. Jesus told a parable: "The kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five were foolish and five were wise" (Matthew 25:1-2). Once the bridegroom arrives, the maidens will escort him to the wedding feast. However, "the bridegroom was long delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep" (Matthew 25:5). At midnight he arrived so they got their lamps ready. But the foolish ones did not have enough oil and wanted the wise ones to give them some of theirs. The foolish virgins go off to buy some oil and while they were gone the bridegroom arrived and the virgins who were ready with their lighted lamps escorted him into the wedding feast and the door was locked. When the foolish virgins arrived, it was too late. They begged, "Lord, Lord, open the door for us!" But the Lord replied, "Amen, I say to you, I do not know you" (Matthew 25:12).

The oil that Jesus speaks of in this parable refers to the good deeds that the disciples of Christ must do to be watchful and ready for the second coming of our Lord. Jesus tells them the deeds (oil) they must do to keep their lamps burning brightly, ready to greet him when he comes. Only by doing good deeds consistent with the Gospel will they be ready to enter eternal life with the bridegroom, our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lamp stand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father" (Matthew 5:14-16).

The foolish have their lamps but not enough oil. They appear to be ready but as far as living their faith, they are empty. They are not practicing their faith. They are like the tree that does not bear fruit. They are like the guest at the wedding banquet without a wedding garment, they are cast out into the darkness.

The wise are those who actively do good deeds right up to the end of their lives. They endure to the end by doing works of love. "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven" (Matthew 7:21).

In two weeks, the Sunday Gospel Reading will be taken from the end of Matthew, chapter 25. This will be about the Final Judgment that Jesus will render when he comes again in glory (Matthew 25:31-46). Jesus tells his disciples what they must do to "inherit the kingdom prepared for them from the foundation of the world" (Matthew 25:34). They must feed the hungry, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, visit the sick and the imprisoned. I will tell you more about this in two weeks.

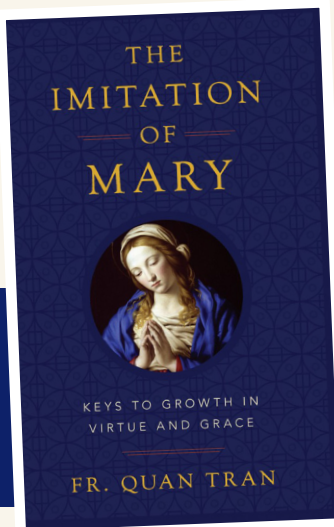

- The elderly and those not able to leave their homes may obtain the indulgence by praying for the dead in front of an image of Jesus or the Blessed Mother.

Other conditions (sacramental confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father) should be completed as soon as possible.

Parish Manager's update

We remain at Tier 2 (Red) of the State's COVID Tier system for at least another week so we will continue to have three options for attending Masses. We can have up to 100 people in the church, 100 people in the parish hall and an unlimited number of people outside in the plaza/parking areas. For those who are outside for Mass, we will provide chairs, audio and video onto the plaza area, weather permitting. Many thanks to our volunteers who are helping with all the extra Mass preparations and for helping clean after each Mass.

About 1/3 of our canopies survived the high winds of 10/26. Thanks again to those who helped save them. We will set them up for Masses when the weather is warmer, and we will try to take them down when it's dark so the lighting on the plaza from our bell lights will be more effective. Since it's now dark by around 5:00 p.m., please drive extra carefully if you are on campus after dark. All the timers for our parking lot lighting have been adjusted, but there is no substitute for driving just a little slower.

Please remember that although the parish center is closed, our front desk staff are working from home. They check voice messages left on our main phone line about twice per hour. So if you need anything from the parish center, just call (714) 846-3359 and leave a message.

Thank you again to all of our volunteers, including those who help us celebrate our various liturgies. In an 11-day period, 10/29 through 11/8, we will have celebrated 44 liturgies (Masses, funerals, weddings, etc.). We couldn't do this without our volunteers. And thanks to those who are able to financially support our busy parish.

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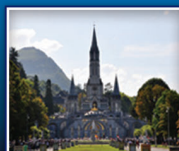
