PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For several weeks I have been reflecting on the Readings from the Gospel according to St. Matthew. Our Lord Jesus Christ has emphasized the importance of putting our faith into action. We must do good to all we encounter especially our least brothers and sisters. We are now at the last Sunday in Ordinary Time. This is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This Gospel Reading is about the Final Judgment. (Matthew 25:31-46) Jesus, the Son of God, became man. He died on the Cross to save us from our sins. He rose from the dead to give us new and eternal life. Now he is separating the blessed from the accursed.

What did the blessed do? They fed the hungry, gave drink to the thirsty, clothed the naked, welcomed the stranger, cared for the sick, and visited the person in prison. The blessed actively put their faith into practice. They lived their faith. They cared for the least of their brothers and sisters. What did the accursed do? They did not care for those in need.

Jesus reminds us that, "Whatever you did for one of the least of the brothers of mine, you did for me." He also tells us, "Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me." We must see Jesus in the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the stranger, the ill, and the imprisoned. We must see our King and Savior in all we encounter today.

Lord Jesus Christ, give me your eyes and your ears that I may see and hear you in the least of my brothers and sisters. Give me your feet and your hands that I may approach and reach out to those in need.

Lord Jesus Christ, I want to be with you for all eternity. Help me to realize I am already with you when I encounter you in the least of my brothers and sisters. If I do not reach out to you now, I will not be with you for eternity.

Parish Manager's update

So much has happened since last week. Where should I start?

As most of you know, Orange County is now back at Tier One (the Purple Tier) on the State's COVID Tier system. That means we can't have any Masses inside our church. It also means that Faith Formation cannot meet inside our buildings. Our school is not impacted by this change. Our students can continue to attend classes here on campus. But any event that would have taken place inside the church must now be done outside.

With the potential for colder outdoor temperatures, please dress as needed for our Southern California fall weather. And you might decide to attend a weekend Mass at a time when the weather is better for you. We are looking at some options that would allow you to stay in your car for Mass if the weather is poor. One option would allow you to watch a livestream Mass using a mobile device in your car. Another option would be to allow you to hear the Mass in your car via an FM transmission (audio only). There are pros and cons for every option.

This move back to Tier One is very disappointing for all of us. And I know some parishioners have very strong opinions on this topic. I guess that includes me. That said, you have proven to be a very loyal flock. We have effectively been out of our church since we started construction back in September of 2018, yet you have attended Masses in the hall, watched livestreaming from your home, and attended Masses on our plaza area. And you've supported our parish both financially and by volunteering. I hope most of us will see this setback as just another inconvenience on our journey. We will get through this, as a united community of faith.

School Principal's letter

November 18, 2020

Dear St. Bonaventure Parish Community,

This past Friday afternoon, I was notified of two unrelated positive cases of COVID-19 in our school community. They were immediately reported to the Orange County Public Health Agency. We complied fully with the Orange County Health Care Agency from Friday, working around the clock through the weekend and into Monday to provide every piece of information requested and answer every question asked. Thus far, there is no evidence of community transmission. At the end of the OCHCA's review, both cases were deemed low exposure risks, and no quarantining was required other than the two initial cases.

Last weekend, we also had a specially certified cleaning team disinfect our entire campus—classrooms, bathrooms, hand washing stations, offices, and lunch tables included.

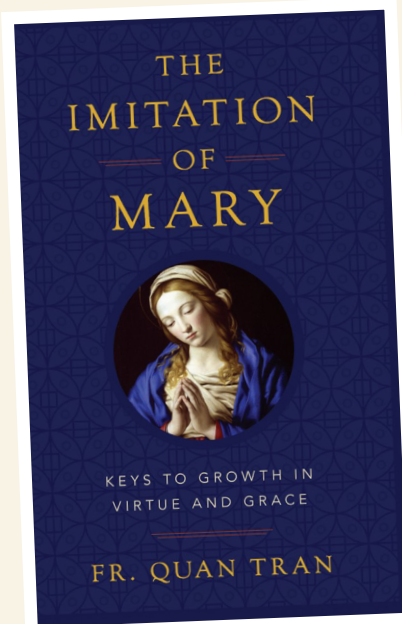
We continue to walk forward in faith, providing our precious students with an academically excellent and Christ-centered education in the safest possible school environment.

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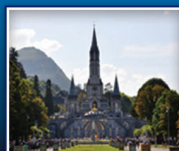
