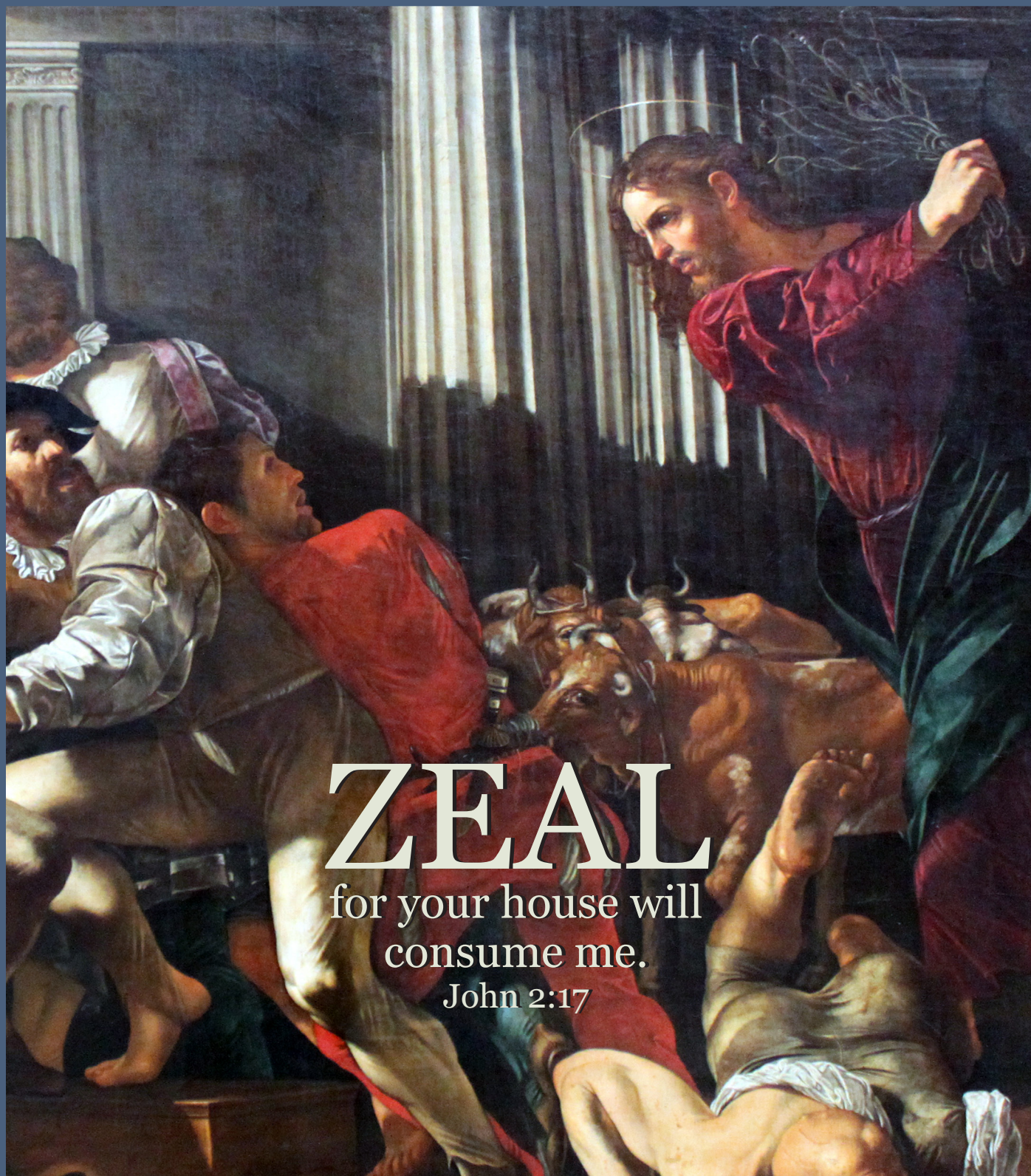

Pastor's corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Prior to today's Gospel Reading, at the beginning of chapter two in the Gospel according to John, we are told about the wedding feast at Cana. The newly married couple ran out of wine. Jesus had the waiters fill Jewish ceremonial washing jars with water and turned the water into wine. But there is a deeper mystery than water being changed into wine. A Jewish practice of ceremonial

washing is transformed not just into wine, God has intervened in human history by sending his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ into our world. John tells us, "Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs in Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him" (John 2:11).

Today's Gospel Reading (John 2:13-25) comes immediately after the wedding feast at Cana. Jesus cast out all the merchants who were at the entrance to the Temple. The merchants were selling animals used for sacrifice in the temple. The money-changers were exchanging various currencies for the half-shekel coin needed for paying the temple tax. Jesus told them, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace" (John 2:16). The Jewish leaders asked Jesus, "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up" (John 2:18-19). The Jewish leaders thought Jesus was referring to the Temple that had been under construction for 46 years. (And we thought our Church renovation took a long time.) Jesus was not referring to the Jerusalem Temple, but to the temple of his body. Once again God intervened in human history. God sent his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ into our world. The Jerusalem Temple was no longer needed. The temple of the body of Jesus was crucified on the Cross and in three days was raised up.

It is wonderful to be gathered in our church to worship our Lord. Along with this, please let our Lord come deeper into your heart and into your life. Spend time in prayer with our crucified and risen Lord. Let our Savior into the temple of your body and soul. Share the love of Jesus with your family, friends, and all you encounter these forty days of Lent.

If you are coming to the 9:00 a.m. Mass today, there are special Scripture Readings that connect with the Rites of Scrutinies that we are doing the next three Sundays. The Scrutinies are special prayers for those who are receiving Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil. Our Catechumens (who are now called the Elect) need our prayers because the devil will do whatever it takes to discourage them from becoming children of God. Our prayers call out to God to give them the strength they need to persevere on their journey to the Sacraments that unite them with the Lord.

Parish Manager's update

As you all know, strong winds during most Masses last weekend forced everyone to attend Mass in the church or in the hall. I think God is telling us we should all be in church! Well, until the COVID pandemic ends, we will continue to place some chairs outside on the plaza and we will have the hall available. We will also place the 75-inch (donated) television on the plaza if the weather permits.

We had a walkthrough of the church last week with the Director of Construction for the Diocese. We walked all around the outside and the inside of our church. The walkthrough lasted about two and a half hours. There were no significant structural issues, mainly issues related to finish and usability (and palm trees). Now we will be meeting with our builder to discuss our warranty list. One positive outcome is that we can now hire an independent roofer to repair the leak in our roof. I hope to have the repair completed within the next two weeks. Then we can start repairing the drywall holes in the church ceiling.

Overall, I think parishioners are doing a good job of social distancing in our pews and wearing masks in our church and hall. If you decide to stand at the back of the church during Mass, please do not lean against our art glass (aka stained glass) windows or the wood framing at the bottom of the windows.

With seating for Mass in three locations (church, plaza and hall), please consider volunteering to become an usher or a Eucharistic Minister. If you can help, please call the Parish Center.

Thank you all for your patience and understanding as everyone finds "their seat" in our church!

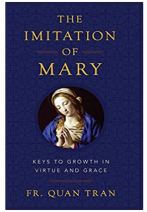
