Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

One of my favorite saints is St. Therese of Lisieux, also known as St. Therese of the Child Jesus. She was born in 1873. She entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux at the age of fifteen and dedicated her short life to the Lord. She died of tuberculosis at the age of twenty-four. She had been told to write about her childhood. She also wrote about her years in the convent. After her death these writings were compiled into a book, "The Story of a Soul, The Autobiography of Saint Therese of Lisieux."

I bring this up because for the last three weeks the Sunday Second Readings have been following the twelfth and thirteenth chapters of St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. These chapters were central to "the little way" of St. Therese of Lisieux. When she read these chapters she wrote, "I read that not everyone can be an apostle, prophet or teacher, that the Church is composed of a variety of members, and that the eye cannot be the hand. Even with such an answer revealed before me, I was not satisfied and did not find peace."

St. Therese continued to read St. Paul's Letter, "Set your desires on the greater gifts. And I will now show you the way which surpasses all others." At last St. Therese had "found peace of mind." She wrote, "Love appeared to me to be the hinge for my vocation...I knew that the Church had a heart and that such a heart appeared to be aflame with love. I knew that one love drove the members of the Church to action...I saw and realized that love sets off the bounds of all vocations, that love is everything, that this same love embraces every time and every place. In one word, that love is everlasting." St. Therese proclaimed, "O Jesus, my love, at last I have found my proper place in the Church, and you gave me that very place, my God. In the heart of the Church, my mother, I will be love, and thus I will be all things, as my desire finds its direction."

This was the vocation that God gave St. Therese. This is also the vocation that God gives each of us. Please read and reflect on St. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, chapters twelve and thirteen. Then concentrate on chapter twelve, verse 31 through chapter thirteen, verse 13. When you are patient, kind, not jealous, not pompous, not inflated, not rude, not seeking your own interests, not quick tempered, not brooding over wrongdoing, then you are responding to God's gift of love. You are rejoicing in the truth. You are following in the footsteps of St. Therese of Lisieux, "In the heart of the Church, my mother, I will be love, and thus I will be all things, as my desire finds its direction." Call out to our Lord Jesus Christ and he will help you to do this:

O God, who open your Kingdom to those who are humble and to little ones, lead us to follow trustingly in the little way of Saint Therese, so that through her intercession we may see your eternal glory revealed. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen. (Collect, Memorial of St. Therese of the Child Jesus)
