

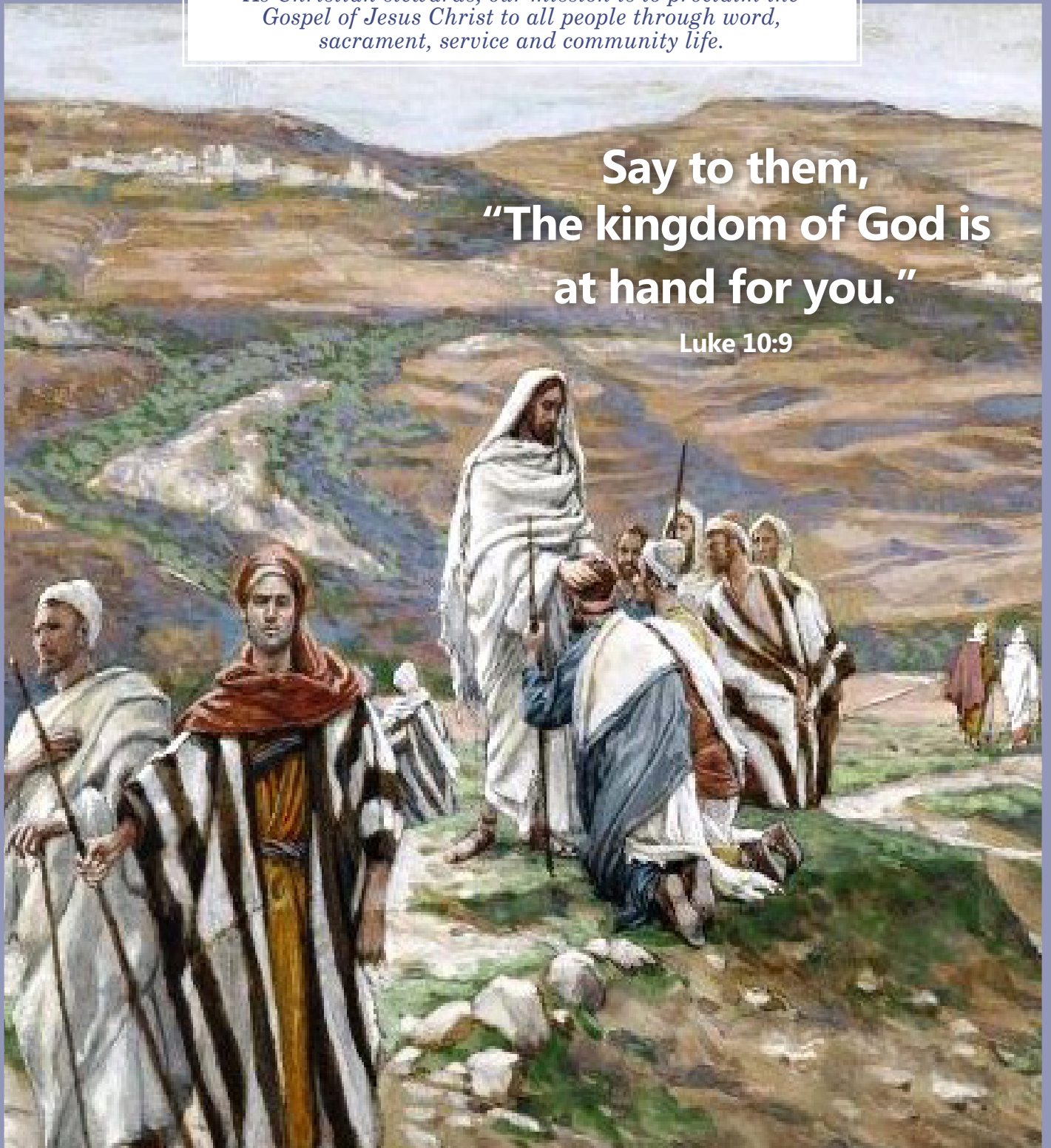

Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Gospel Reading on this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus sends seventy-two disciples in pairs to all the towns and villages he is going to visit. You would think that they could cover more ground if he sent one to each town or village. However, sending them out two by two was important. It wasn't just what they were called to say, "Peace to this household," and "The Kingdom of God is at hand." It was also important for people to see how the two disciples treated each other. Were they showing care and concern for each other? Or was one of them saying, "No, let me tell the people about the Kingdom, you got to proclaim it in the last village." Were they kind to each other or arguing with each other? This would help those listening to realize these disciples were not only believing the Good News of Jesus Christ, they were living the Good News.

You are called to do this as well. You must not only believe the Good News of Jesus Christ, you must live the Good News daily. You live the Good News when you love God with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind and when you, "Love your neighbor as yourself." (Luke 10:27) Today's Alleluia Verse says it well, "Alleluia, Alleluia, Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly. Alleluia, Alleluia."

On this 4th of July weekend, we reflect on the founding of our country. The following is the Opening Prayer (Collect) at Mass on Independence Day, Monday, 4th of July:

Father of all nations and ages, we recall the day when our country claimed its place among the family of nations; for what has been achieved we give you thanks, for the work that still remains we ask your help, and as you have called us from many peoples to be one nation, grant that, under your providence, our country may share your blessings with all the peoples of the earth. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

May we continue to pray that Freedom of Religion will be honored, respected and lived daily.

†FR. JOHN G. BLOCK
July 16, 1936–June 21, 2022

Rev. John G. Block was ordained to the Sacred Priesthood on December 18, 1964 for the Diocese of Miami, Florida at the Church of Christ the King in Rome, Italy. He received a Licentiate in Sacred Theology in June 1964 and a Doctorate in Sacred Theology in June 1970 from the Gregorian University, Rome, Italy.

He taught Theology at St Vincent De Paul Regional Seminary, Boynton Beach, Florida from July 1, 1971 to July 1, 1980, at which time he was appointed Pastor of St Mark Parish, Boynton Beach. He became a member of the Diocese of Palm Beach, Florida upon its establishment on October 24, 1984. He was Pastor of St Mark Parish until August 1, 1997. He retired from the Diocese of Palm Beach on August 1, 2001.

Fr. John lived as a retired priest in residence at St. Bonaventure parish for 20 years from 1998 to 2018 faithfully offering himself in service to the sacramental life of the parish community. He lived at Santiago de Compostela Church in Lake Forest from August 2018 until June 2022. The parish communities of St. Bonaventure and Santiago de Compostela will dearly miss him.

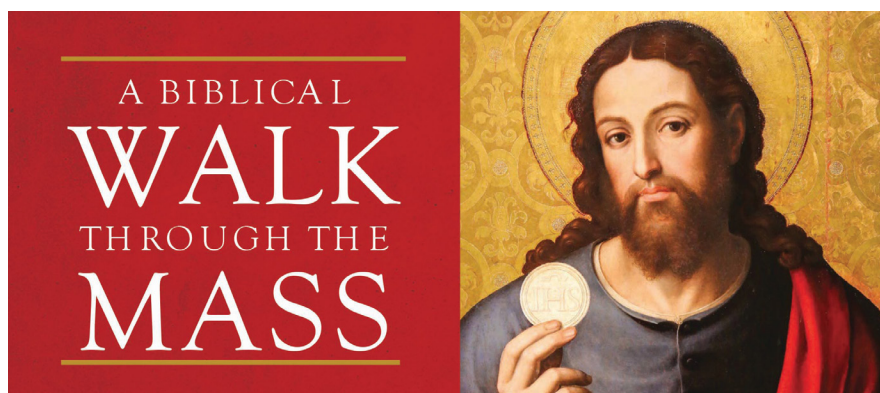


BETHLEHEM CHRISTIAN FAMILIES

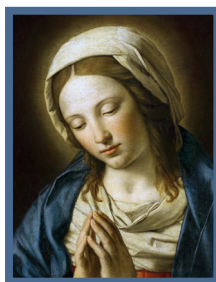

CCH operates several local shelters serving women and children who have fallen into homelessness due to crises such as job loss or domestic violence. 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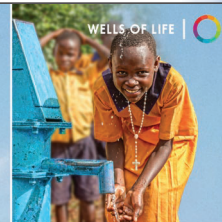
