PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time in the Gospel Reading, Jesus warns his disciples to turn away from sin and live his Good News, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough. After the master of the house has arisen and locked the door, then will you stand outside knocking and saying, 'Lord, open the door for us.' He will reply, 'I do not know where you are from.'" Jesus will not let you into the kingdom of God just by saying, "We ate and drank in your company and you taught in our streets." The Lord will say, "Depart from me, all you evildoers!" (Luke 13:22-30)

We do not know when the Second Coming of our Lord will happen or when our life will come to an end in this world. We strengthen our faith through prayer and participation in Mass, where we are nourished by the Word of God and Holy Communion. However, we cannot stop there. We must live our faith every day. "You shall love the Lord, your God with your all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. And you shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:37-40)

We may be surprised, maybe even shocked, by those who enter the kingdom of God. Remember, "God does not see as a mortal, who sees appearances. The Lord looks into the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7) We must leave judgement to the Lord. We hear in the Gospel of Matthew how Jesus the Son of God will judge us, "Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me. ... whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me." (Matthew 25:31-46)

Therefore, go and do likewise.

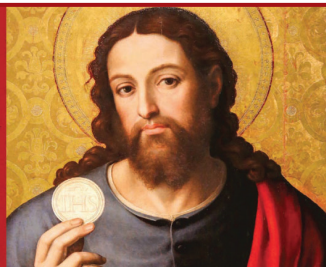

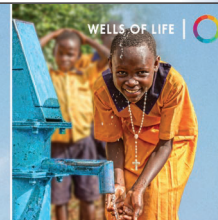

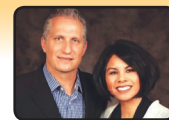
