Pastor's corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel Reading (Luke 17:5-10) begins with the apostles asking Jesus, "Increase our faith." This may refer to the warning Jesus gave to them just prior to this, "Things that cause sin will inevitably occur, but woe to the person through whom they occur. It would be better for him if a millstone was put around his neck and he be thrown into the sea than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin (Luke 17:1-2)." The apostles were begging Jesus to not let this happen to them. They asked Jesus to help them always be good examples to those they were shepherding, and not be the cause for them to sin. Jesus was probably also referring to the next passage, "Be on your guard! If your brother sins, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. And if he wrongs you seven times in one day and returns to you seven times saying, 'I am sorry,' you should forgive him" (Luke 17:3-4). The apostles were also begging Jesus to give them a forgiving heart and not hold grudges against disciples that kept sinning but were then remorseful and asked to be forgiven.

Jesus wants the apostles to ask his help to be faithful. He also challenges them to put their faith into practice. He wants them to live their faith. He wants them to serve the disciples they are shepherding. Being servant-leaders is what they are called to do. As Jesus says, "When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do'" (Luke 17:10).

We celebrate today Respect Life Sunday. We have important work to do. We are called to protect the lives of all human beings from conception to natural death. This year we need to protect babies in the womb whose lives are being threatened with California State Proposition 1. This proposition would create an amendment to the State Constitution that would permanently expand and vastly increase abortion in our State. Proposition 1 would remove limits on late-term abortions. It will permit unrestricted abortions for any reason at any time even up to the moment of birth. Please vote "NO" on Proposition 1.

We need to put our faith into practice and protect babies in the womb. We also must help mothers to choose life for their babies and help them when they choose life. The Bishops of California are actively committed to uniting, increasing, and making readily available all life-affirming resources in our state for women facing unexpected pregnancies. Please check the bulletin for more information on this especially under the title: "We Were Born Ready."

God our Creator, we give thanks to you, who alone have the power to impart the breath of life as you form each of us in our mother's womb; grant, we pray, that we, whom you have made stewards of creation, may remain faithful to this sacred trust and constant in safeguarding the dignity of every human life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen. (*Roman Missal, Prayers for Various Occasions, Prayer For Giving Thanks To God For The Gift Of Life, 48/1*)

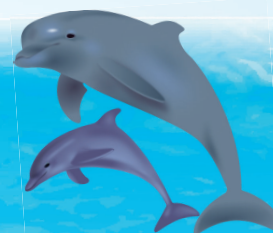

RESPECT LIFE MONTH

NOVENA For the Defeat of Proposition 1 and to End Abortion

This year, California voters will decide whether to ratify Proposition 1, an extreme constitutional amendment that would enshrine a permanent right to abortion without limits at taxpayer expense, for any reason, even for women from other states and up to moments before birth! CAcatholic.org/Prop1

In response, the bishops of California are inviting all Catholics to engage in prayer and fasting to end abortion and for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to form the minds and hearts of California citizens to defeat Proposition 1. This week, our bishops will continue hosting the *Novena to Our Lady of the Holy Rosary to Defeat Proposition 1* from September 29 to October 7. Visit CAcatholic.org/Prop1 for the daily video messages.

At St. Bonaventure, we will say the Novena prayers in church at 7:30 a.m. each day, concluding October 7. All are invited to join us in church or participate at home. Here is the format we are using:



1. Daily Novena Prayer

✚ In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. Our dearest Mother Mary, behold us, your children, as we humbly come in prayer before you. In you, the Author of Life assumed the fullness of human nature, redeeming us by sacrificing his life for our salvation, obtaining for us participation in eternal life through the Holy Spirit. With you, we treasure every human life created in God's image, and we grieve for any action or social structure that undermines that dignity. We come before you today, led by the Holy Spirit and united as one family in your Son, to offer this Novena as a spiritual bouquet, with confidence in the power of your intercession before our Almighty God and Father. May he hear and grant our earnest request that the hearts of voters in our state be moved to reject and defeat Proposition 1, and may we be guided by the Holy Spirit to rebuild and strengthen a culture of life in the hearts and minds of all we encounter. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

3. Conclude by Reciting a Decade of the Rosary

PENNIES FROM HEAVEN

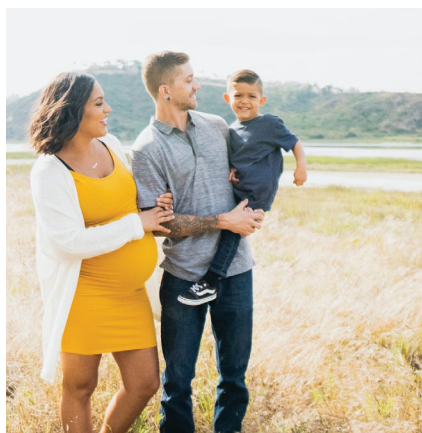
Please support the Pennies from Heaven collection (renamed the *Walking with Moms* collection), which benefits local pro-life pregnancy clinics and shelters helping women in need.

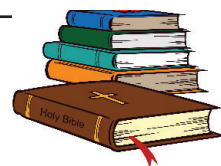

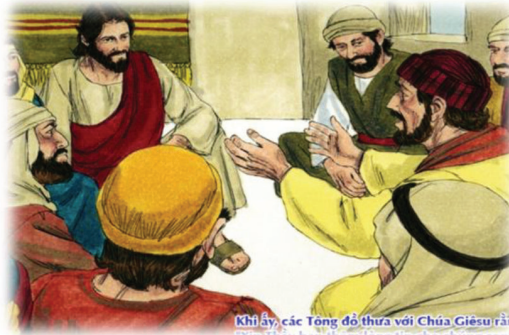

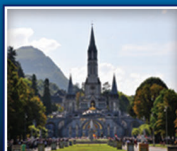
