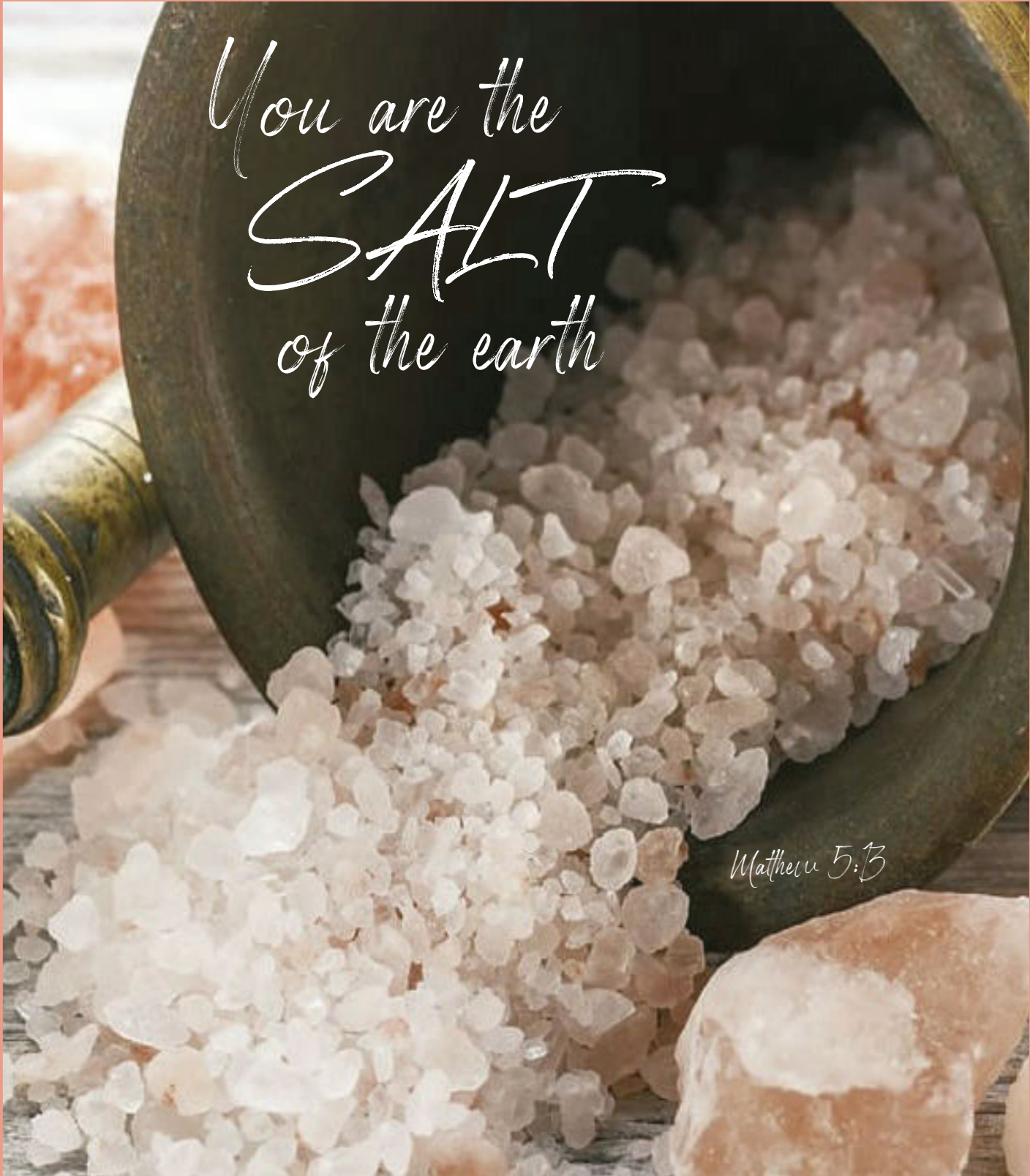

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have arrived at the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The First Scripture Reading is from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah. He announces the message of the Lord: "Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed; your vindication shall go before you, and the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. ... If you bestow your bread on the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday." (Isaiah 58:7-10)

Our Responsorial Psalm today is Psalm 112: "Light shines through the darkness for the upright; he is gracious and merciful and just. Well for the man who is gracious and lends, who conducts his affairs with justice."

The Alleluia Verse is: "I am the light of the world, says the Lord; whoever follows me will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

The Gospel this Sunday is a continuation of the Sermon on the Mount. Immediately after the Beatitudes, Jesus said to his disciples: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." (Matthew 5:13-16)

We truly believe that Jesus is the light of the world. However, when Jesus tells us, "You are the light of the world." We are embarrassed because we know our light is not always shining before others. Our good deeds are not always there. We don't always reach out to those in need and help the homeless.

However, today, we have a new day to, "Bestow bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted." We have another opportunity to let, "Your light shine before others." Today, you have another opportunity to glorify your heavenly Father."
