On the Road to Emmaus

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Gospel Reading (Luke 24:13-35) on this Third Sunday of Easter, two disciples of Jesus were walking back to their village of Emmaus which was seven miles from Jerusalem. This was happening the same day that Jesus had risen from the dead. Jesus started walking with them, but they did not recognize him. Jesus asked them what they were talking about. The disciples told him about the mighty prophet Jesus and how upset they were that the religious authorities had had him crucified. They thought Jesus "would be the one to redeem Israel." Then they told him that some women from their group had announced that the tomb where Jesus had been buried was empty and that "a vision of angels" announced that he was alive.

Jesus said to them, "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the scriptures.

By this time, they had arrived at their village. Jesus made it look like he was going farther. They invited him to stay at their house. "While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened, and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight."

I love their response to their encounter with Jesus, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?" Who knew "heart burn" could be good for you!

They quickly ran back to Jerusalem to tell the other disciples about their encounter with the Lord. But the disciples were already announcing, "The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!"

There are times when Jesus is walking with us, and we don't know it.

Do we recognize Jesus in the "Breaking of the Bread? This is the name the early Church gave to what we now call the Mass or the Holy Eucharist. Do we encounter Jesus at Mass? Do we encounter Jesus in the "Breaking of the Bread?"

I leave you with one last question. Why did the two disciples leave Jerusalem after the Crucifixion? Shouldn't they have stayed with the other disciples in that locked room? It appears that after the death of Jesus on the Cross, these two disciples had given up on Jesus, even after the women disciples had announced that he was alive. However, Jesus had not given up on them. Jesus walked with them. Jesus lovingly interpreted all the Old Testament Scriptures that referred to him. Jesus announced to them, "Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?"

Keep this in mind in case you (or a loved one) become disillusioned with your belief in Jesus Christ. Jesus does not write us off. He does not say, "Well, if that's how you feel, then I have nothing more to do with you." No, Jesus walks with us no matter what. He lovingly comes to us. He spends time letting us get to know him. And at some point, it hits us, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." Let our Beloved Jesus open your heart. "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" And Jesus invites you to stay with him. He invites you to have a meal with him. He invites you to the Sacred Meal of the Holy Eucharist, "While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened, and they recognized him [Jesus]." I pray that through your reflection on Holy Scriptures and participating in the Mass, "the Breaking of the Bread," you will come to know and embrace our Beloved Lord Jesus Christ who died and rose from the dead for you and nourishes you with Holy Communion.

Two of the shelters we serve, **CASA TERESA** and **PRECIOUS LIFE SHELTER**, provide residential support services in a safe, loving environment for homeless, pregnant, adult women with no place to have their child. They are joyfully asking that all donations be new.

Casa Teresa has asked for basic items for the babies (baby wipes, diapers, and baby clothes) and for the mothers (bath items for showering, body sprays and lotions, liquid hand soaps, bath towels, robes, socks (non fuzzy), flip flops (sizes 6-13 or medium-XXL), hair brushes, nail polish, boxes of tissue, journals and maternity clothes. Some fun items include: body spray, body lotion, nail polish, Lee press-on nails, pampering items (just no candles or bath bombs). And of course, baby clothes, maternity clothes and diapers are always helpful!

Precious Life Shelter has asked for items for Mother's Day such as diaper bags, small hand sanitizers, USB flash drives (16, 32, 64) for moms for school and gift cards for Kohl's and Shoe City for necessary items such as shoes, work pants, and undergarments. Some baby items that are also needed are neutral-colored sleepers and crawlers, small packets for the diaper bags of disposable trash bags, packs of lotion, baby wash and shampoo, diaper rash cream and mitts for baby's hands.

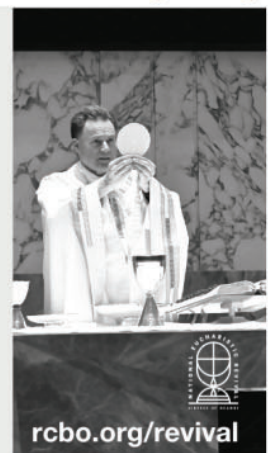
