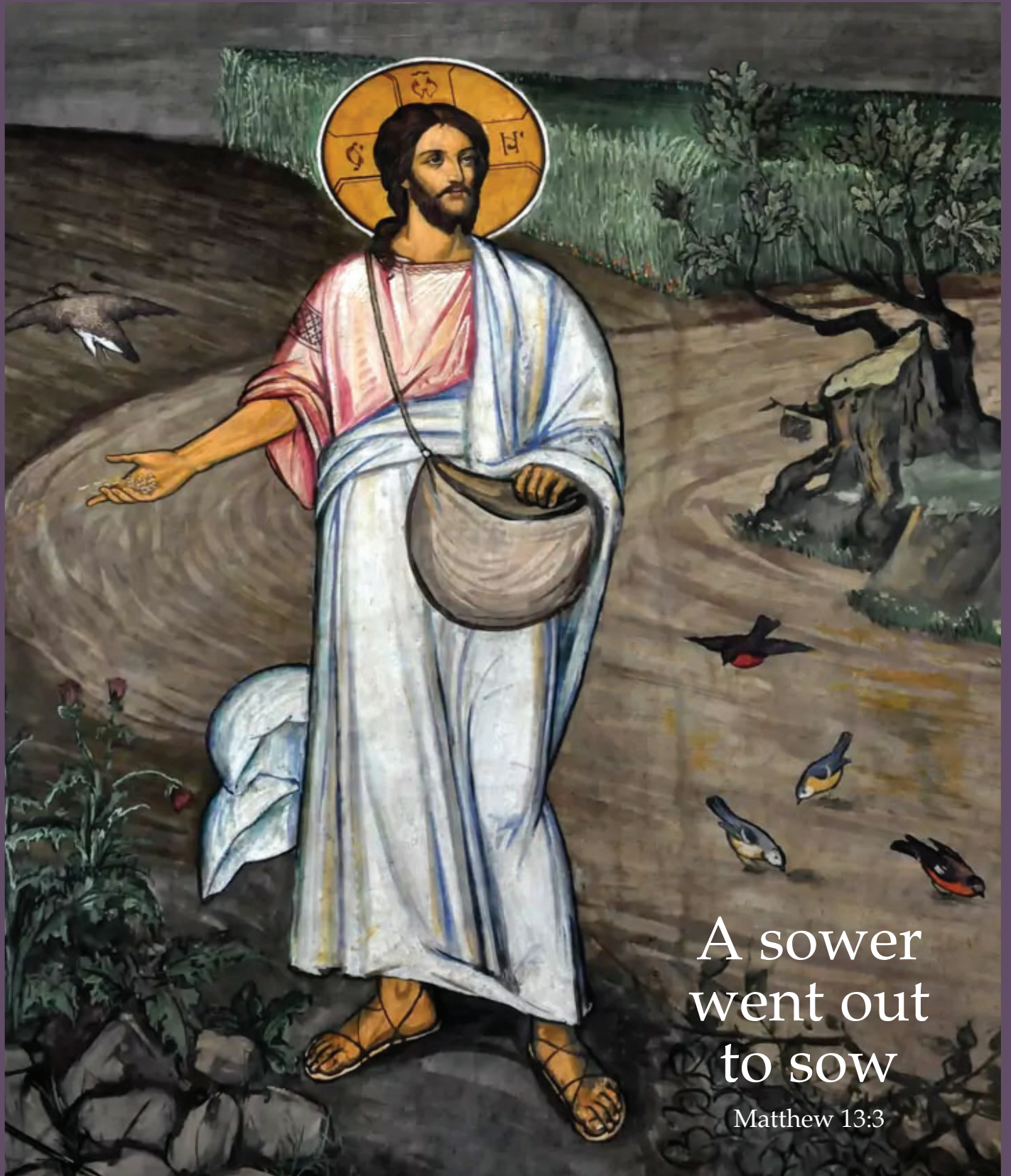

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

What a great first week I had in the parish. When people asked me how I am doing or how I like the parish, my response was, "I am still in the honeymoon." Yes, that is true. The first weekend was quite delightful for me. I got to celebrate six Sunday Masses out of eight to introduce myself and received a very warm welcome by all. I truly felt blessed by your love and support. At the end of the day, I walked on cloud nine with a halo on top of my head. Praise and thanks be to God.

Prior to my arrival to the parish, I asked the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) for a list of those who are sick and homebound, and the list has 42 parishioners. Starting last Monday, I began visiting a few of them a day. As I talked to them, I am very grateful to Fr. Joe, Fr. Ruben, and the EMHC's for taking care of their spiritual needs very well. They are mostly elderly and long-time parishioners. Some joined the parish since the day "we celebrated Mass in a warehouse." I brought them Holy Communion, heard their confession, and anointed them. This week I will continue to visit a few more every day.

With the parish staff, we are very fortunate to have a great team, who are talented and dedicated. The past week I had an opportunity to talk to each one of them about their work, their commitment, and their dream for the parish. Their dedication truly gives me the confidence to move the parish forward in faith and joy.

Along with the staff, there is a devoted team of volunteers in the parish. They are really the backbone of the life of the parish and the incredible inspiration to make our community spiritually and socially vibrant. Everyday there are always some who come as early as 5:00 in the morning, and some stay as late as 9:00 in the evening to make sure our liturgies are well prepared and our church is securely safe. I am very grateful to them for their services.

This past weekend, we had the pleasure to witness the blessing of married couples who celebrate their wedding anniversary in July. Some just got married last year, and there are those who have been married for 45 years, 50 years, and 62 years. May God continue to bless them with happiness and peace. Bishop Vann was here at the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, and he imparted the blessing to them, and a special blessing upon me as I began to serve. His visit to the parish was such a sweet surprise, and we look forward to more visits from him. In my conversation with him, he reminded me to contact his secretaries to arrange for my installation as pastor of the parish, and I am very grateful for this honor.

Last but not least, the parish handed out approximately a thousand copies of Bishop Robert Barron's book, *This Is My Body*. For me, Bishop Barron is a new version of Bishop Fulton Sheen of the good old days. The book that you picked up is a response to the present situation of our Catholic Church in the United States which he called "a spiritual disaster" because two-thirds of Catholics "held that the Eucharistic elements are merely symbolic of Jesus' presence." The two important chapters of this book, "The Eucharist as Sacred Meal" and "The Eucharist as Sacrifice," will help us to understand the Mass better and to love it dearly. I pray that you will take time to read it and share it with your family and friends.

As I am new to the parish, I would like to meet you every weekend. Please meet me before or after Mass to say, "Hi." May God bless you, and I am looking forward to seeing you every weekend.

July 29-30



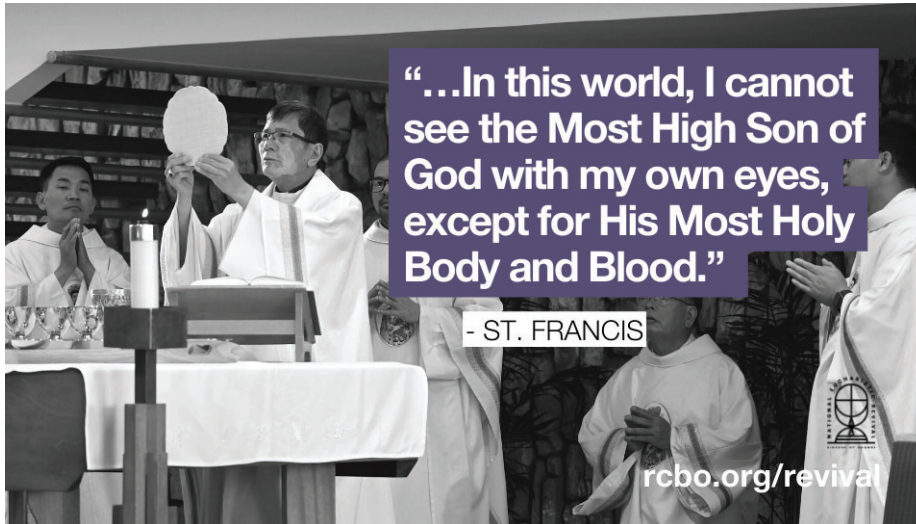

Q&A

Saint Bonaventure, Our Patron Saint PART IX – Grace as a Gift of God, conclusion

Quotations from Bonaventure's *Breviloquium*, edited by Dominic V. Monti, O.F.M.

3. "Again, the one who enjoys God possesses God. Hence, it follows that together with that grace which, by its God-conforming nature, leads to the enjoyment of God, there is also bestowed the uncreated gift, the Holy Spirit. Whoever possesses it possesses God's own self.

4. Now no one possesses God without being possessed by God in a special way. And no one possesses and is possessed by God without loving God and being loved by God in a particular and incomparable manner, as in the case of a bride and groom where each loves and is loved by the other. And no one is loved in this way without being adopted as a child entitled to an eternal inheritance. Therefore, the 'grace which makes pleasing' makes the soul the temple of God, the bride of Christ, and the daughter of the eternal Father. And since this cannot occur except through a supremely gracious condescension of the part of God, it could not be caused by some naturally implanted habit, but only by a free gift divinely infused. This is most evident if we consider **what** it truly means to be God's temple and God's child, and to be joined to God as in wedlock by the bond of love and grace. (Bonaventure believed there is a special union effected between the person of the Holy Spirit and the created human will.)

5. Finally, our mind is not conformed to the Blessed Trinity except through the uprightness of our free choice, and this occurs only through the strength of virtue, the splendor of truth, and the fervor of love. For the strength of virtue cleanses, strengthens, and elevates the soul; the splendor of truth enlightens and reforms it, conforming it to God; and the fervor of love perfects and vivifies it and unites it with God. When all this is accomplished, a person is made pleasing and acceptable to God.

It so follows that this God-likening influence is said to have all ... of the above-mentioned effects, although it is named only from the last and most complete of them. Thus it is called 'the grace that makes pleasing' [*gratis fratum faciens*] because it makes the one who possesses it acceptable in God's sight. For not only is it given freely by God, it also conforms to God and leads to God as an end, so that the work that came from God might return to God. In this way, it achieves, in the manner of an intelligible circle, the fulfillment of all rational spirits.

Speaking very generally 'grace' refers to the assistance generously and freely granted by God to a creature for any of its activities whatsoever. Without this support, we could do nothing; in fact, we could not even continue to exist."

BIENVENIDO A NUESTRO NUEVO PARROCO PADRE VINCENT PHAM

Padre Vincent nació en Vietnam en 1968 en una familia católica tradicional formada por 6 niños y 2 niñas. Es el tercero de mayor a menor edad. En 1994 sus padres tomaron una decisión muy difícil lo enviaron lejos en busca de libertad. El viaje de 7 días para cruzar el océano pacífico fue de vida o muerte. Y gracias a la providencia de Dios sobrevivió. Pasó los siguientes ocho meses en varios campos de refugiados en Indonesia para prepararse a la vida en los Estados Unidos. Llegó aquí en 1985. Tenía 17 años, sin dinero y sin hablar inglés. Se graduó de la escuela preparatoria de Santa Ana Valley en 1988. Ingresó al Seminario de San Juan en Camarillo, CA, en el cual pasó cinco años y continuó por otros cuatro años en teología. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1997 por el Obispo Norman McFarland. Por los últimos 26 años ha servido como vicario parroquial en San Policarpo, Santa Bárbara y San Norberto. En 2006, fue nombrado párroco de la parroquia de la Purísima. Después de seis años en esa asignación, pasó los próximos dos años en la Unión Teológica de Berkeley y tres más años en la Universidad Católica de América en Washington, D.C. Cuando regresó sirvió dos años en la parroquia de San Timoteo y los últimos cuatro años en el Centro Católico Vietnamita.

LA VIRGEN DEL CARMEN

16 de Julio

Desde 1913, en la ciudad de Puntarenas, Costa Rica, la Virgen del Carmen es reconocida como la Virgen del Mar. En aquel año un barco llamado el Galileo naufraga en una tempestad y el pueblo angustiado por sus seres queridos recurrió al templo de la Virgen para pedir auxilio. Algunos días después todos los tripulantes fueron rescatados y llevados a Puntarenas. Según los tripulantes, mientras las lluvias y vientos amenazaban al Galileo una mujer los animó a que se echasen al agua y nadaran a tierra firme. Allí ella los alimentó y los acompañó hasta que fueron rescatados. Llenos de alegría, el pueblo llevó a los rescatados a la iglesia para dar gracias. Estos reconocieron a la Virgen del Carmen como la mujer que los había ayudado. Desde entonces el sábado más cercano al 16 de julio, el pueblo celebra en grande la fiesta del Carmen con grandes desfiles de barcos y yates. Entre música y fuegos artificiales los costarricenses vienen en embarcaciones adornadas desde toda la nación a celebrar con la Virgen del Mar que también se encuentra en una embarcación.

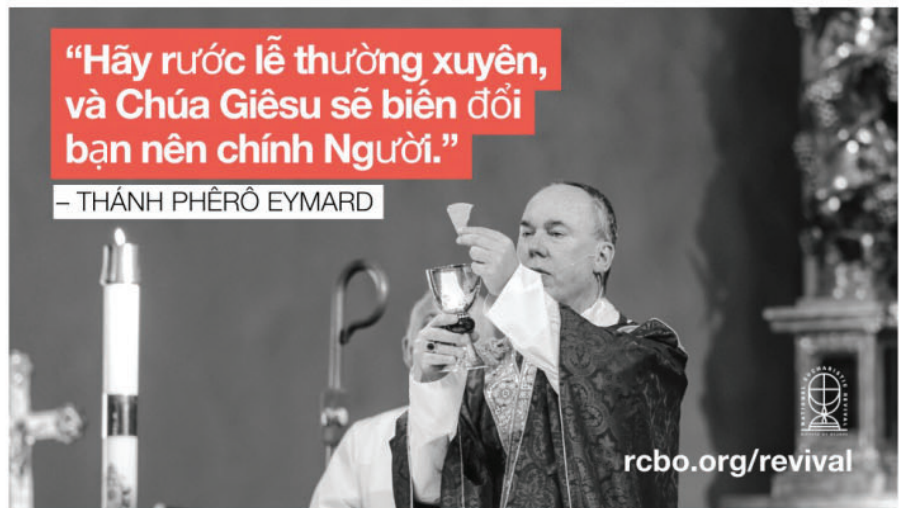

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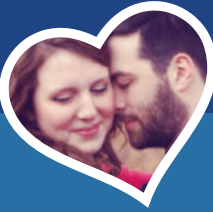
