Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As our confirmation students are preparing for their three-day retreat from Friday, November 17 to Sunday, November 19, I ask you to pray for them and for all those who help them. We pray that the Holy Spirit be poured upon them for holiness, wisdom, and strength. The more they are open to the Holy Spirit, the stronger they will be in their faith and service. As they are entering their young adult phase of life, may they grow in their love of the Holy Eucharist and turn to God for every situation in life, especially in times of challenges. I will be with them on Saturday to help them celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The theme for the retreat is **“Living Sacrifice,”** taken from a letter of Saint Paul to the Romans. He writes: “I urge you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship” (12:1). We all know young people nowadays are pulled from many different directions. In the face of these challenges, many make the right choices while others unfortunately falter. We do not want any of them to suffer the consequences of poor choices but to succeed in life and at the same time shine brightly in their faith. To reach this success, they need a lot of prayer and faith support from all of us, so like Saint Paul says, they can be “a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God.”

What a great theme chosen by Cristina Bernal and her husband, DJ Bernal. Cristina has been a wonderful confirmation coordinator. With much help from Elida Aviña, Dorene Saporito, and many volunteers, she is leading the students into active learning and appreciation of their Catholic faith.

Since September, our Faith Formation Ministry in three languages—English, Spanish, and Vietnamese—has been very busy. The staff and volunteers have registered more than 600 students, and classes are held throughout the week. I would like to take this opportunity to thank them for their love of catechizing students. All of these catechists are volunteers, and they serve from their hearts. When you meet them, please smile and tell them how much you appreciate their service.

I would also like to thank the parents. You have done a fabulous job, taking your children to class and picking them up. Your commitment reminds me of the question that you were asked at the baptism of your children:

“Parents, you have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so, you are accepting the responsibility of training him/her in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him/her up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us by loving God and our neighbor. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?”

Obviously, not only do you understand it, but you also commit to raising your children in the practice of faith. May God bless you and all that we do for the spiritual benefits of your children.

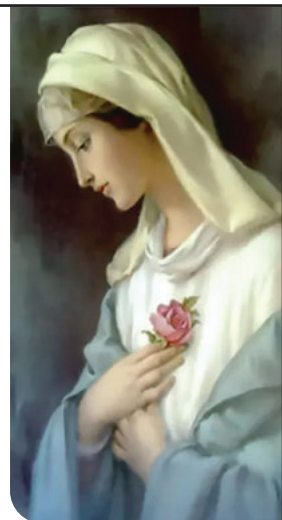

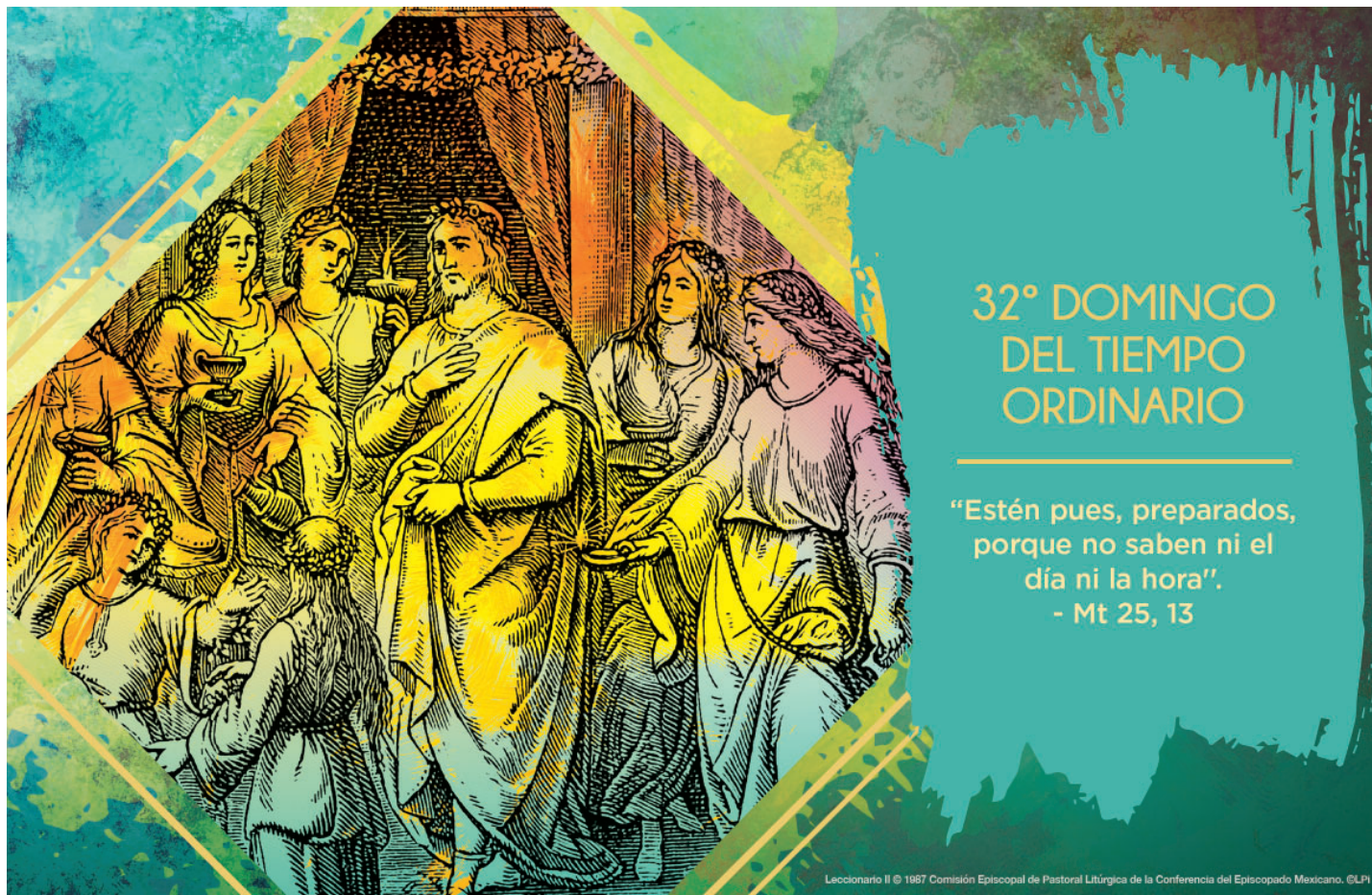

32° DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

No podemos detener el tiempo y éste pasa volando, los días se van aprisa y los años vuelan. A veces nos preguntamos: ¿Qué fue lo que hice hoy? ¿Qué he hecho en los años que he vivido? La respuesta puede variar, quizá hemos aprovechado todo en la vida, o quizá no hemos logrado todo lo que hubiéramos querido. Pero, hoy, el Evangelio no invita a estar prevenidos, a estar bien preparados. Nos invita a comenzar de nuevo y llenar nuestra alcuza de aceite con actitudes y valores de acuerdo al Evangelio. A tener esperanza, a estar despiertos para cuando llegue la hora.

“Ser sabios y prudentes significa no esperar hasta el último momento para corresponder a la gracia de Dios, sino hacerlo activamente de inmediato, empezar ahora. [...] Si queremos estar preparados para el último encuentro con el Señor, debemos cooperar con él a partir de ahora y realizar buenas acciones inspiradas en su amor” (Papa Francisco 11-08-2020). Si notamos en la parábola, todas las vírgenes se despertaron al escuchar el aviso de que llegaba el novio. Todas ellas deseaban participar en el banquete. Sin embargo, solo las prudentes estaban listas para disfrutar de la boda. Señor, ayúdame, a vivir preparado en todo, que siempre esté listo con buenas obras y tenga tiempo para esperar tu llamada. Actualmente, ¿cómo me preparo para acudir al banquete de la Eucaristía? Estoy puntual, y listo para participar.

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXXII MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM A Mt 25, 1-13 "Kia chàng rể đến, hãy ra đón người!"

Các em lớp thêm sức đang chuẩn bị đi tĩnh tâm ba ngày cuối tuần 17, 18, và 19 tháng 11, xin quý ông bà và anh chị em thêm lời cầu nguyện cho các em và những người giúp các em. Xin Chúa Thánh Thần ngự xuống để các em được thánh thiện, khôn ngoan, và tràn đầy sức mạnh. Các em càng mở rộng tâm hồn để đón nhận Đức Chúa Thánh Thần, các em sẽ mạnh mẽ hơn trong niềm tin và tinh thần phục vụ. Ở vào tuổi chuẩn bị trưởng thành, xin cho các em luôn kính yêu Thánh Thể Chúa và tìm đến với Ngài trong mọi hoàn cảnh, cách riêng trong những lúc khó khăn thử thách. Tôi cũng sẽ đến với các em ngày thứ Bảy để giúp các em xưng tội.

Chủ đề cho buổi tĩnh tâm là, "Living Sacrifice – Cửa Lễ Sống Động," được trích từ thư của Thánh Phaolô gửi giáo đoàn Rôma, "Anh chị em thân mến, tôi nài xin anh chị em vì lượng từ bi Thiên Chúa, hãy hiến thân anh chị em làm cửa lễ sống động và thánh thiện, đẹp lòng Chúa" (12:1). Con em của chúng ta ngày hôm nay phải chịu lời kéo từ nhiều phía trong cuộc sống. Đối diện với những thách đố này, nhiều em có được những chọn lựa khôn ngoan, nhưng cũng có những em mắc phải sai lầm. Chúng ta không muốn em nào phải lầm lỡ để rồi phải trả giá cho những hậu quả, nhưng mong các em thành công trong cuộc sống và tỏa sáng niềm tin của mình ở mọi nơi. Để có được thành quả này, các em cần rất nhiều lời cầu nguyện và sự nâng đỡ tinh thần từ chúng ta, để như Thánh Phaolô nói, các em sẽ trở nên "cửa lễ sống động và thánh thiện, đẹp lòng Chúa."

Cô Cristina và chồng là anh DJ Bernal đã chọn một chủ đề rất hay. Cô hiện là người điều hành rất tuyệt vời các lớp thêm sức. Nhờ có sự trợ giúp của cô Elida Avida, Dorene Saporito, và nhiều giảng viên giáo lý thiện nguyện khác, cô Cristina đã và đang hướng dẫn các em tích cực học hỏi về đức tin và hành diện về chính mình là người Công Giáo.

Bắt đầu từ tháng 9 đến giờ, Mục Vụ Giáo Lý cho cả ba ngôn ngữ rất bận rộn. Có trên 600 em đã ghi danh và các lớp học được giảng dạy gần như trong suốt tuần. Nhân dịp này tôi chân thành tri ân các giảng viên giáo lý đã ưu ái giảng dạy giáo lý cho các em. Họ là những người thiện nguyện, phục vụ từ trái tim với tinh thần yêu quý trẻ em. Nếu gặp gỡ họ, xin quý vị nở một nụ cười và dành cho họ một lời cảm ơn chân thành.

Tôi cũng không quên cảm ơn quý vị phụ huynh. Quý vị thực sự là những bậc cha mẹ tuyệt vời, đưa đón con đi học giáo lý hàng tuần. Tinh thần dân thân của quý vị làm tôi nhớ lại câu hỏi trong ngày con cái của quý vị được rửa tội.

Khi xin phép Rửa Tội cho con cái, anh chị lãnh nhận trách nhiệm giáo dục em trong Đức Tin, để em tuân giữ các giới răn Chúa là mến Chúa yêu người như Chúa Kitô đã dạy chúng ta. Anh chị có ý thức điều đó không?

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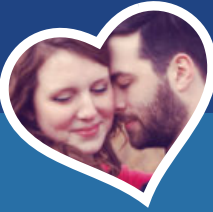
