PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Tuesday, December 12th. She is the patroness of the Americas and of our diocese. On this special occasion, let us briefly reflect on the historical account of her apparitions. According to a manuscript written in the Aztec native language Nahuatl, by the scholar Antonio Valeriano sometime after 1556, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared four times to an indigenous peasant, Juan Diego, on the hill of Tepeyac in Mexico in 1531. In her conversation with Juan, Mary introduced herself as the Mother of God and the mother of all humanity.

In her first apparition, Mary asked Juan to request the local archbishop to build her a shrine on that same spot, in order for her to show and share her love and compassion with all people. Juan Diego took her words and delivered them to Archbishop Zumárraga, who was Archbishop of what is now Mexico City. Zumárraga dismissed him in disbelief and asked him to provide proof of his story and proof of the Lady's identity.

Juan Diego went back to Tepeyac and met the Blessed Virgin Mary for the second time. This time she told him to climb to the top of the hill and pick some flowers to present to the archbishop. That was during the wintertime when no flowers were expected to bloom, but the miracle happened. Juan Diego was able to find an abundance of rare flowers and gathered them into his cloak, known as a tilma. When he presented these flowers to Archbishop Zumárraga, the flowers fell out. The archbishop was surprised to recognize that these were Castillian roses, which were not found in Mexico. The archbishop was then more surprised to see on Juan Diego's tilma the miraculously imprinted, colorful image of the Virgin herself.

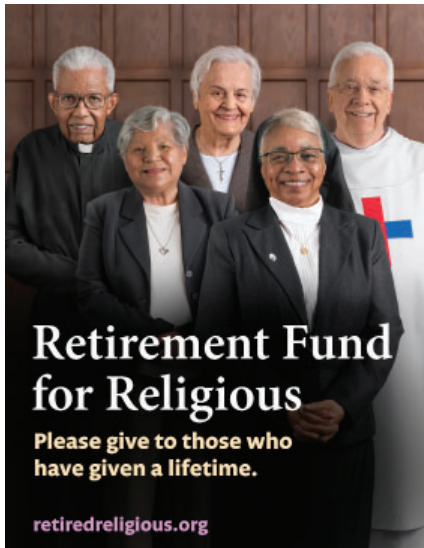
Not long after the apparitions, the original shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe was built, and the present Basilica was constructed in 1974, where the miraculous image of Mary has been preserved. Every year there are over 20 million pilgrims visiting this basilica to honor Mary, to pray for her intercession, and to view the original image.

On this Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the Church recognizes in the Opening Prayer of the Mass that God has placed us "under the singular protection of your Son's most holy Mother," and pray that we "may seek with ever more lively faith the progress of peoples in the ways of justice and peace."

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN II MÙA VỌNG NĂM B

Mc 1, 1-8 "Hãy dọn đường Chúa cho ngay thẳng".

Trong tuần này chúng ta mừng lễ kính Đức Mẹ Guadalupe vào ngày thứ Ba, 12 tháng 12. Đây là lễ bốn mạng của tất cả các quốc gia thuộc Châu Mỹ, trong đó có Hoa Kỳ, và cũng là bốn mạng của giáo phận chúng ta. Trong dịp này chúng ta tìm hiểu sơ qua về sự kiện lịch sử. Theo một tài liệu được viết bằng tiếng thổ âm của người Aztec vào khoảng năm 1556, Đức Mẹ đã hiện ra bốn lần với một người thổ dân tên là Juan Diego, trên một ngọn đồi của vùng Tepeyac nước Mỹ Tây Cơ, vào năm 1531. Trong những lần nói chuyện với Juan Diego, Đức Mẹ cho biết Mẹ là Mẹ Thiên Chúa và là mẹ của nhân loại.

Trong lần hiện ra lần thứ nhất, Đức Mẹ truyền cho Juan Diego tới xin đức tổng giám mục địa phương xây cho Đức Mẹ một nhà nguyện ngay tại nơi Đức Mẹ đang hiện ra, để Đức Mẹ ban ơn cho những ai đến với Mẹ. Juan đã đến tìm gặp Đức TGM Zumárraga, hiện đang là Đức TGM địa phương mà ngày nay là Mexico City, nhưng ngài không tin lời Juan nói và kêu anh phải cho bằng chứng của câu chuyện và bằng chứng về danh tính Đức Mẹ.

Juan trở về đồi Tepeyac thưa lại với Đức Mẹ như vậy trong lần Đức Mẹ hiện ra lần thứ hai. Đức Mẹ truyền cho anh đi lên đỉnh đồi để hái hoa mang về cho Đức TGM. Vào lúc đó đang là mùa đông lạnh lẽo, nên cây cối không thể nảy chồi, nảy mầm, và nở hoa được. Tuy nhiên Juan Diego vẫn có thể hái được rất nhiều những bông hoa lạ và gói vào vạt áo choàng của anh. Khi anh đến đưa hoa cho Đức TGM Zumárraga để làm bằng chứng, thì ngài rất ngạc nhiên vì đây là loài hoa hồng Castillian, mà nước Mỹ chưa bao giờ có. Ngạc nhiên hơn nữa là Đức TGM thấy có hình Đức Mẹ được in trên vạt áo của Juan Diego.

Sau đó vài năm, Đài Đức Mẹ Guadalupe đã được dựng lên ngay chỗ Đức Mẹ đã hiện ra, và vương cung thánh đường hiện tại đã được xây cất vào năm 1974. Nơi đây đang lưu giữ vạt áo của Juan Diego với bức ảnh nhiệm màu thuở xưa. Hàng năm có trên 20 triệu khách hành hương tới kính viếng Đức Mẹ và cũng để chiêm ngắm ảnh Mẹ.

Trong Lời Nguyên Nhập Lễ của Thánh Lễ kính Đức Mẹ Guadalupe, Giáo Hội tin tưởng rằng Thiên Chúa đã đặt chúng ta “dưới sự che chở đặc biệt của Mẹ rất thánh,” và cầu xin cho chúng ta “với đức tin sống động hơn bao giờ hết hằng hướng tới sự tiến bộ của các dân tộc theo đường lối công lý và hòa bình.”

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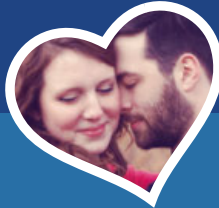
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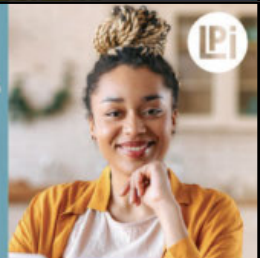
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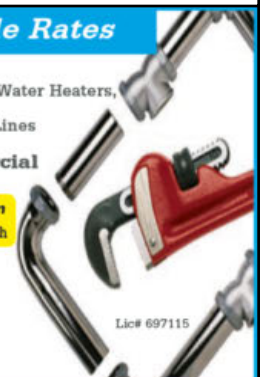
