PASTOR'S CORNER

Happy New Year to you all!

With great joy, we conclude the year of grace in gratitude to God for His many blessings upon each one of us, family, and parish community. I hope you had a wonderful time with your family and friends celebrating Christmas together in church and at home. It is great to know that the birth of Christ does bring people together. That is why, around this time every year, millions of people in the United States travel from one place to another to be with their loved ones.

Reflecting upon the past year, many of us rejoiced in personal or family's happy events, but I also acknowledge that many others had to deal with challenges, difficulties, and sorrows. Now as we look back, whether in joys or in sorrows, we realize that God was always with us. In the words of St. Paul, please allow me to "rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep" (Rom 12:15).

On December 18, 2023, the Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith, with the approval of the Holy Father, issued the declaration, *Fiducia Supplicans*. As Bishop Robert Barron reads it, "The document allows for the possibility of blessing those in irregular or same-sex relationships." In response to this document, the U.S. Conference of Bishops (USCCB) offered the following statement:

"The Declaration issued today by the Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith (DDF) articulated a distinction between liturgical (sacramental) blessings, and pastoral blessings, which may be given to persons who desire God's loving grace in their lives. The Church's teaching on marriage has not changed, and this declaration affirms that, while also making an effort to accompany people through the imparting of pastoral blessings because each of us needs God's healing love and mercy in our lives."

I hope that this statement helps to diffuse any confusion which has arisen and continues to instill in us confidence in God's love for his people.

As we enter the New Year 2024, and you are still looking for a recipient for your year-end giving, your beloved St. Bonaventure Parish will be very grateful to receive any part of your donation. You can continue to give through January. No giving is too small, and it is worthy of tax deduction.

The Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but it is a holy day. As we begin the New Year, the Faithful are encouraged to attend Mass. The title "Mother of God" is from the Greek "theotokos" literally translated "God-bearer." Theotokos was adopted at the Ecumenical Council at Ephesus as a way to assert the divinity of Christ. This oldest feast of Mary celebrates Mary's role in always directing the believer toward her Son.



On this day, let us ask for the intercession of the Holy Family that we may have the strength and courage to stand against all those who seek to destroy the life of traditional families. Let us also pray for the intercession of St. Joseph, who was the Protector of the Child Jesus and Mary, and is the Protector of the Holy Catholic Church. Amen. —*Saint John Paul II*

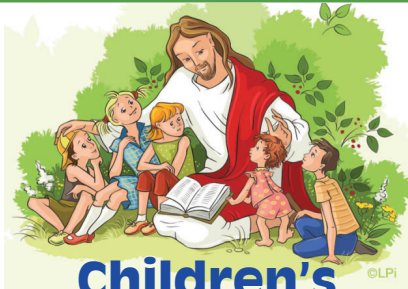

NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER FOR PEACE



January 1, 2024

In 2002 the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) voted to designate January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God, as a National Day of Prayer for Peace. On January 1 we ask Mary, our Mother and Mother of the Church, to intercede for us as her children.

Mary is the model believer who believed the unfathomable message of Gabriel, endured the initial doubt of Joseph and the exile in Egypt, witnessed the events of Christ's public life, and was tried at the foot of the cross. We, as members of Christ, with Mary as our Mother and Model, are called to the same faith, now in the grim reality of war, of terrorism, of hatred and of unrestrained violence.

We may feel powerless in the face of so much real and potential evil, but we cannot allow ourselves the luxury of powerlessness. In doing so we shortchange the power of God who hears our prayer and works through us. We are called to believe that God has a plan for us and that God's plan will prevail. We are also called to collaborate in that plan by our own prayer made in union with Christ, our Head, by our efforts to promote peace with those whose lives intersect with ours.

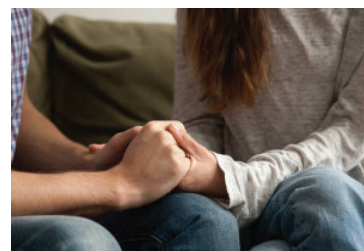

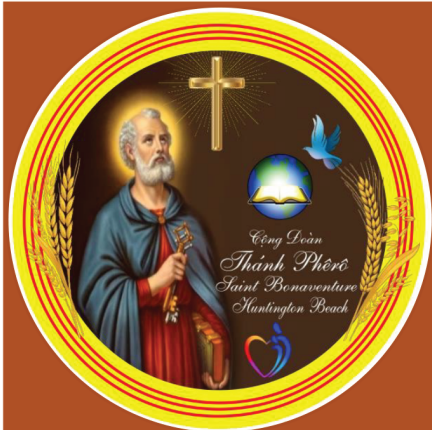

Kính gửi lời chào Năm Mới đến quý ông bà và anh chị em!

Với niềm hân hoan trong Chúa, năm cũ khép lại với nhiều hồng ân Chúa đã ban cho. Hy vọng quý vị đã có những thời gian tuyệt vời với gia đình và thân hữu trong những ngày vừa qua. Lễ Giáng Sinh hàng năm thường là dịp quy tụ những người thân lại với nhau. Đó là lý do trong thời gian này cả hàng triệu người trên nước Mỹ đã di chuyển từ nơi này sang nơi kia để sum họp với người thân của mình.

Tưởng nhớ lại năm vừa qua, nhiều người chúng ta đã đón nhận những niềm vui khác nhau, nhưng nhiều người khác phải trải qua những khó khăn, thử thách, hay tang chế. Tuy nhiên, dù vui dù buồn, chúng ta vẫn cảm nghiệm được sự hiện diện của Chúa trong mọi sự kiện của cuộc sống. Xin mượn lời của Thánh Phaolô để được “vui với ai mừng vui, khóc với ai đang khổ sầu” (Rom 12:15).

Trong ngày 18 tháng 12 vừa qua, Bộ Giáo Lý và Đức Tin, với sự chấp thuận của Đức Thánh Cha, đã công bố bản, *Fiducia Supplicans*. Theo Đức Cha Robert Barron, trong bản công bố này có đoạn ghi, “Cho phép các cặp đồng tính hoặc bất hợp lệ có thể được lãnh phép lành.” Ngay sau khi bản công bố này được phát hành, Hội Đồng Giám Mục Hoa Kỳ có đưa ra bản tuyên bố như sau:

Bản tuyên bố do Bộ Giáo Lý và Đức Tin (DDF) của Vatican đưa ra hôm nay nêu rõ sự khác biệt giữa các phép lành trong phụng vụ (bí tích) và các phép lành mục vụ. Các phép lành mục vụ (pastoral blessings) có thể được ban cho những người mong muốn lãnh nhận ân sủng yêu thương của Thiên Chúa trong cuộc sống của họ. Giáo huấn của Giáo Hội về hôn nhân không thay đổi, và tuyên bố này khẳng định điều đó, đồng thời cho thấy nỗ lực đồng hành với mọi người thông qua việc ban các phép lành mục vụ vì mỗi người chúng ta cần tình yêu và lòng thương xót chữa lành của Thiên Chúa trong cuộc sống của mình.

Hy vọng bản tuyên bố này có thể giảm bớt những hoang mang và căng thẳng đang xảy ra, và nó sẽ tiếp tục giúp chúng ta vững tin vào tình yêu của Thiên Chúa dành cho dân Ngài.

Hàng năm cũng vào thời gian này, nhiều người có thói quen làm công việc bác ái cuối năm, tiếng Anh gọi là “year-end giving.” Giáo Xứ St. Bonaventure sẽ rất tri ân khi đón nhận được quà tặng của quý vị. Không có món quà nào quá nhỏ đâu. Mỗi quà tặng đều được khấu trừ thuế.

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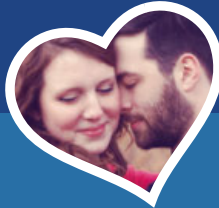

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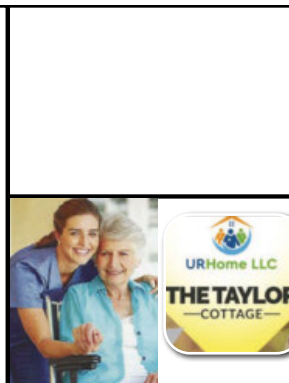
