## Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last Sunday, as I visited the catechumens and candidates who have been preparing themselves to be baptized on the Easter Vigil, I had the pleasure of hearing Mr. Jim Wallace's presentation on the Season of Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, and ends after the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, March 28. The Season of Lent is 40 days, which corresponds to the 40 days and 40 nights Jesus fasted and prayed in the desert before his public ministry. The actual days in the Season of Lent are more than 40 days because they include Sundays, which are not part of Lent, Sunday being the celebration of Jesus' resurrection.

The Season of Lent has its origin from the apostolic time, but it was not formalized until the 4th century. Back then, those who wanted to join the Church were catechized for six weeks prior to Easter, and those who wanted to return to the Church from their excommunication also spent this much time in repentance before they could be received back into the Church.

This excerpt from *Britannica* gives a brief description of the origin of Lent and Ash Wednesday:

It was a time of preparation of candidates for baptism and a time of penance for grievous sinners who were excluded from Communion and were preparing for their restoration. As a sign of their penitence, they wore sackcloth and were sprinkled with ashes. This form of public penance began to die out in the 9th century. It became customary for all the faithful to be reminded of the need for penitence and of their own mortality by receiving a *memento mori* in the form of ashes on their foreheads on the first day of Lent—hence the name Ash Wednesday.

Two special days in Lent on which Catholics are called to fast and abstain from meat are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Bishop Timothy Freyer explains that "All Catholics without a medical impediment from age 18 until age 59 are to fast (one full meal and two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal) and all Catholics without a medical impediment 14 years and older are to abstain from meat." In addition, Canon Law 1251 teaches that "Abstinence from meat...is to be observed on all Fridays, unless a solemnity should fall on a Friday."

As we enter this season of great spirituality, let us commit ourselves to practice the three traditional pillars of Lent: praying, fasting and almsgiving. Lent is not only about what we will be giving up, but also about what we are willing to take on.

## World Marriage Day Sunday, February 11

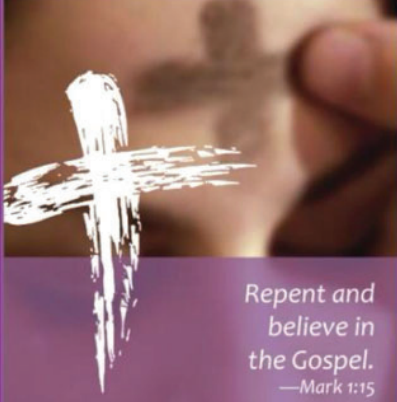

The 2024 Lenten Season begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14 and concludes with the commencement of the Easter Triduum and the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, March 28.

**LENT** provides a valuable occasion for us to ready ourselves for the Easter festivities, to accompany catechumens as they prepare for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, and for the already baptized to renew our commitment through acts of penance, prayer, and charitable giving. During Lent, there is a special emphasis on dedicating ourselves to both spiritual and corporal works of mercy. These actions serve as tangible expressions of our faith, demonstrating our commitment to assisting our neighbors in both physical and spiritual dimensions. Below, are the guidelines outlining the practices that Catholics in the Diocese of Orange are called to observe during this sacred season of Lent.

### FASTING

✦ Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (**February 14**) and Good Friday (**March 29**).

To *fast* means a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

### ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

✦ Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

To *abstain* means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

### LENTEN PRACTICES

✦ The faithful are encouraged during Lent to attend daily Mass, receive Holy Communion, participate in penance services and receive sacramental absolution; to take part in public and private exercises of piety, give generously to works of religion and charity, perform acts of kindness toward the sick, aged and the poor; to practice voluntary self-denial, especially regarding food, drink and worldly amusements; and to pray more fervently, particularly for the intentions of the Holy Father.

✦ Lent is an admirable time to preach the Gospel message of reconciliation and for pastors to make available frequent communal celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In this way the social and ecclesial aspects of sin and reconciliation may be underscored.

✦ To afford the faithful opportunities to participate in Lenten prayer services, pastors are encouraged to have such prayer services at least twice a week, including the Way of the Cross on Fridays, Exposition and Benediction, Evening Prayer and evening Masses.

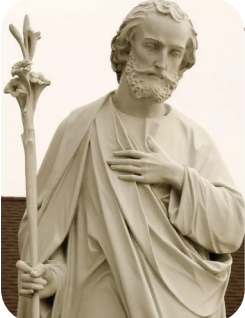

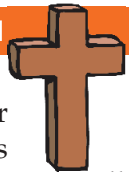

## CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN VI MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM B

**Mc 1, 40-45 "Bệnh cùi biến mất và người ấy được sạch"**

Kính thưa quý ông bà và anh chị em:

Chúa Nhật tuần trước, tôi ghé thăm lớp giáo lý tân tòng và được nghe ông Jim Wallace đang trình bày về Mùa Chay. Hàng năm Mùa Chay bắt đầu với Thứ Tư Lễ Tro và kết thúc sau Thánh Lễ Tiệc Ly chiều Thứ Năm Tuần Thánh. Thời gian của Mùa Chay là 40 ngày, theo với 40 đêm ngày Chúa Giêsu chay tịnh và cầu nguyện trong hoang địa. Những ngày Chúa Nhật trong Mùa Chay không tính vào trong số 40 ngày bởi Chúa Nhật là ngày mừng Chúa sống lại.

Mùa Chay có nguồn gốc từ thời các tông đồ, nhưng đợi mãi đến thế kỷ IV mới được Giáo Hội đưa vào trong phụng vụ. Vào thời bấy giờ, những ai muốn gia nhập Giáo Hội Công Giáo phải học giáo lý trong sáu tuần trước Lễ Phục Sinh, và những ai đã bị vạ tuyệt thông mà muốn trở lại cũng phải dùng cùng thời gian này để sám hối. Dưới đây là một đoạn được trích từ sách Britanica, diễn giải ngắn gọn về nguồn gốc của Mùa Chay và Thứ Tư Lễ Tro.

Đây là thời gian cho các dự tòng chuẩn bị để được rửa tội và cũng là thời gian cho những ai mắc tội trọng, đang bị vạ tuyệt thông, ăn năn sám hối để trở về với Giáo Hội. Như dấu chỉ của lòng ăn năn sám hối, họ mặc áo nhặm và rắc tro lên người. Hình thức sám hối công khai này đã từ từ biến mất trong thế kỷ IX. Tuy nhiên nó đã trở thành thói quen cho nhiều tín hữu và nhắc nhở họ cần phải sám hối và thân phận phải chết của mình. Do vậy họ đã lãnh tro trên trán vào ngày đầu tiên của Mùa Chay—từ đó có tên gọi là Thứ Tư Lễ Tro.

Hai ngày đặc biệt trong Mùa Chay mà chúng ta phải ăn chay kiêng thịt đó là Thứ Tư Lễ Tro và Thứ Sáu Tuần Thánh. Đức Cha Timothy Freyer nhắc nhở rằng, "Tất cả những tín hữu Công Giáo, nếu không vì lý do sức khỏe, tuổi từ 18 đến 59, buộc phải ăn chay (một bữa ăn no và hai bữa ăn ít đi. Hai bữa này không được nhiều hơn một bữa ăn no), và những tín hữu Công Giáo, nếu không vì lý do sức khỏe, tuổi từ 14 trở lên, buộc phải kiêng thịt." Thêm vào đó, Giáo Luật 1251 dạy rằng các tín hữu buộc phải kiêng thịt các ngày Thứ Sáu trong Mùa Chay, ngoại trừ những ngày lễ trọng được mừng vào ngày Thứ Sáu.

Chúng ta đang bước vào mùa tràn đầy ân sủng Chúa. Chúng ta hãy cố gắng thực hiện ba việc làm truyền thống của Mùa Chay, đó là: cầu nguyện, chay tịnh, và bố thí. Mùa Chay không chỉ về những gì chúng ta muốn từ bỏ, mà còn về những gì chúng ta sẵn sàng thực hiện.

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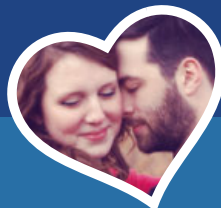
